GIFT AID

Gift Aid is a Government scheme that allows charities to claim back 25% of eligible donations from UK taxpayers. The current Tax Allowance in the UK is £12,570.00 and the current basic rate on income tax over the threshold is 20%. If you are a taxpayer, the parish can claim back 25p for every pound of the tax you have paid, for parish funds. As income rises and the tax threshold remains unchanged more people are becoming taxpayers. If you are now a taxpayer, please consider becoming a Gift Aider to help the parish earn some extra income. All you must do is fill in the Gift Aid Declaration form, and we will do the rest. Each year you will receive a letter from the parish Priest with details of your donations for the previous tax year.
