





### Breakfast Muffins on the Go ...



### **Ingredients:**

2 tbsp. Oil

2 ½ cups Ore-Ida Shredded Hash Brown

Potatoes

2 cups mixed cut-up fresh vegetables (small broccoli florets, chopped red peppers, shredded carrots) Note: Modify ingredients using vegetables you prefer

1 cup shredded cheddar cheese (your choice)

8 eggs

3 tbsp Milk or Heavy Cream

1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese

### **Directions:**

- 1. Heat oven to 375°F.
- 2. Heat oil in large nonstick skillet on medium-high heat. Add potatoes and fresh vegetables; mix lightly. Cook 6 to 8 min. or until potatoes are browned, stirring occasionally.
- 3. Spoon into 12 muffin pan cups sprayed with cooking spray; top with cheddar.
- 4. Whisk remaining ingredients until blended; pour over ingredients in muffin cups.
- 5. Bake 15 min. or until knife inserted in centers comes out clean. Cool 5 min. before removing cups from pan to serve.
