This is to certify that Mr Michalis Roditis as agent of IOM – International Organisation for Migration since 2015 and up to date he has been covering duties in capacity of vessel operator for the evacuation of refugees in the Gulf of Aden, to Obock IOM transit center in Djibouti, from ports in Yemen (Mukkala, Al Hodeidah and Aden).

Deployment conducted through contracting: RODITIS SHIPPING AGENCY, IMO No: 1925507, Vendor UNGM No. 443511 also being the Operations Manager for SAMWELL LIMITED - Marine Company based in Cyprus.

The tasks assigned included:

- locating suitable vessels for immediate response in refugee crisis in the region of AFRICA and MIDDLE EAST
- arrange positioning,
- obtain all need permits permits (both international and local authorities),
- actively participate in specific procurement requirements
- arrange safe evacuation of refugees from war zones to safe ports as IOM contracted vendor.

Following initially presented references, as well as overall experience working with, Mr. Michalis Roditis proved being at disposal on short notice for any specific requirements made by IOM (and other relevant Organizations), aiming soonest possible prompt response, and availability 24/7.

It is highly required as well as strong commitments that consider also personal appearance and supervision in remote and areas where ever need.

IOM achieved task and evacuated safely refugees from Yemen to Djibouti, that part considering sea operations were actively involving Mr. Michalis Roditis, RODITIS SHIPPING AGENCY and SAMWELL LIMITED.
