



No-See-Um Contest

What is it?

- The No-See-Um contest is an optional game played simultaneously during your monthly AGO tournaments **starting in February** and ends with the two-day May Championship tournament.
- Your tournament scorecard serves as the scorecard for this contest.
- The Contest will not be concluded until after several (typically 5) regular monthly tournaments.
- Cost to enter the game is a **one-time entry fee of \$20**.
- Sign-up online, pay cash or send a check with a note indicating you want in the No-See-Um Contest. Entries must be received **before teeing off at the February tournament**. You will be notified and refunded if you were not able to be included.

➤ How it works:

- The Committee will randomly draw two names from the entrants to compete against each other **blindly** for low **NET** score. You do not know who you are playing against.
- Winners and losers **will not be notified**. This contest will go on simultaneously during several regular monthly tournaments until its conclusion.
- Course handicaps from the regular monthly tournament are used. The lower NET score from the two competitors moves on to the next level or tier. Ties will be broken using the AGO system of comparing net scores on handicap holes.
- The process repeats itself during the monthly AGO tournaments until the field is reduced to only two (or three) finalists competing for a **grand prize and a runner-up prize**.
- **If you miss an AGO regular monthly tournament during the contest period you are out of the NO-SEE-UM contest.**
- The **NO-SEE-UM** component is that nobody knows who their opponent is and nobody knows if they have been eliminated until we announce the winners at our **Annual Banquet in June**. A chart demonstrating the progression will be provided at that time.
 - **Grand Prize is \$400 – Runner-up is \$100** (based on 32 players)
