The Burlingame Art Society was organized in 1957 by a group of artists who wanted to practice the principles of traditional art in our present day world. Our membership includes men and women actively participating in the pursuit of visual arts and a friendly relationship among artists as well as those who are genuinely interested in learning about it.

We are artists with a purpose to promote two-dimensional art and the appreciation of that art in our community. Our efforts are not only directed to adults but to encourage young people, through the BAS scholarship program, to pursue the arts.

The Burlingame Art Society members exhibit their works in local venues outside the city, providing an opportunity to share their talents with the general public.

Throughout the year, besides the monthly meetings, the Burlingame Art Society hosts the Annual Spring Art Show exhibit and juried competition, Wine and Cheese Critiques in the Fall and Spring and the Annual Holiday Awards Luncheon in December.

We meet the second Monday of the month, September through June, (except for December's luncheon) at Burlingame Public Library, Lane Room, 480 Primrose Rd, Burlingame, 7:00 pm. We encourage each member to bring a recent painting (no older than 5 years) of his/her own work, to the meetings.

All meetings feature a guest professional artist/instructor who demonstrates his/her medium. The guest artist judges all member paintings for first, second, third and honorable mention awards and ribbons are awarded. The members present at the meeting chose popular choice award. First place award and popular choice given at each meeting are then eligible to participate for the Artist of the Year award. A member cannot win a first place award again for that calendar year. He/she can be awarded a second, third, honorable or popular choice award at anytime during the year. This rule only applies to the regular monthly meeting awards.

The society publishes a monthly e-newsletter, titled the Palette. It contains announcements of ongoing, and upcoming shows, exhibits, and general information about the activities of the membership. It is also available to the public. In addition to receiving the newsletter member artists may link their art website to the BAS website at no charge.

Art accepted by the society is limited to two-dimensional works rendered in Oil, Watercolor, Pastel, Pencil, Acrylics, Ink, Mixed Medium and collage. Digital art, pottery, sculpture, jewelry and textiles are not accepted. Artwork submitted for judging must indicate the source of the image, i.e., 1) original, 2) from another artist's work, 3) from a commercially published photograph. It is the artist's responsibility to adhere to applicable copyright laws.
