Hope to see you there.....

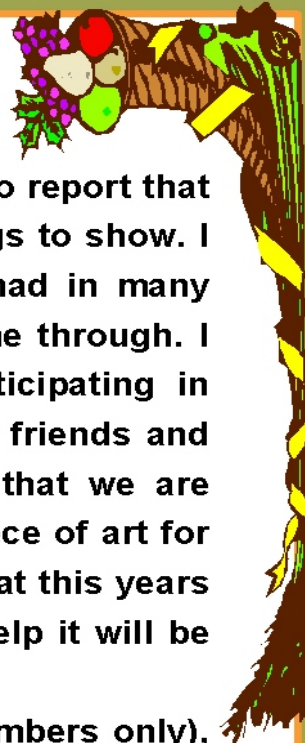
UP NEXT

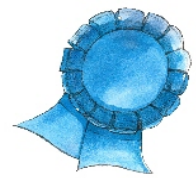

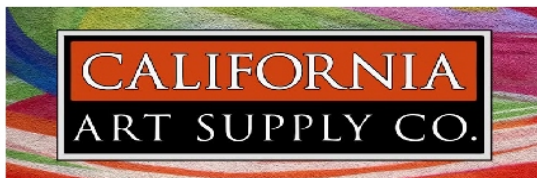

MEETING RECAP

Guest artist, William (Bill) Dunn, treated us to an inspiring and fun watercolor demonstration focusing on capturing the lively atmosphere of a city street scene. Using a reference photo of a Chinatown street, he showed how to translate complex urban detail into a fresh, expressive painting. Starting with large, loose washes, Bill blocked in the sky and building shapes, letting colors mingle wet-into-wet to suggest light and atmosphere. He emphasized keeping confident brushstrokes, hard & soft edges and balancing warm & cool tones.



The red lanterns became a key visual anchor, painted boldly over the lighter background washes. He showed restraint in detail, suggesting windows and signage with minimal marks and to bring the scene to life, he added the crossing figure with dynamic color contrast... a bright shirt and jeans. Bill likes using "Saunders Waterford" 140lb watercolor paper, large brushes like "King Art"-size #20, "Neutral Tint" to darken colors without making them muddy and he especially likes "Holbein" brand paints.

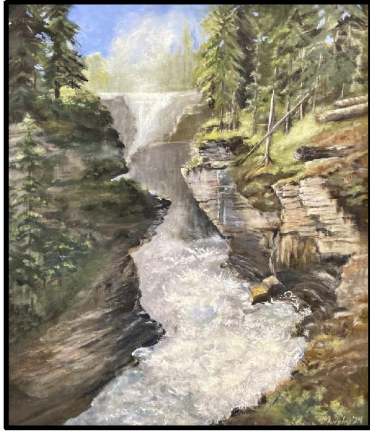

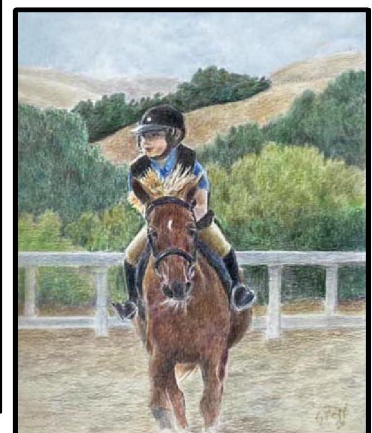
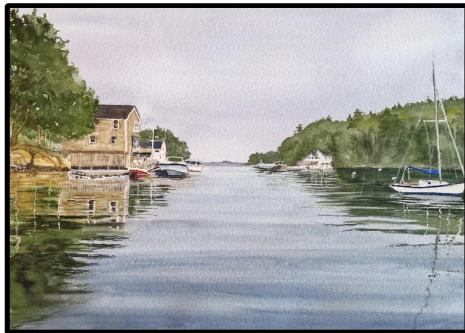
