

The Burlingame Art Society (BAS) was organized in 1957 by a group of artists who wanted to practice the principles of traditional art in present day. Our members are men & women actively engaging in pursuing visual arts and friendly relationships among fellow artists, as well as those genuinely interested in learning about art.

We are artists with a purpose to promote the appreciation of two-dimensional art in our community. Our efforts are not only directed to adults, but also to encourage young people to pursue the arts through our BAS scholarship program.

We meet on the second Saturday of each month, excluding July & August (for summer break), also the December date may or may not change for our Holiday/Awards event. The meetings take place at the Burlingame Community Center (850 Burlingame Ave.), from 1:30 to 4:00 pm. Aside from the monthly meetings, BAS hosts an Annual Juried Art Show and our December Holiday Awards Event.

Each meeting features a guest artist who will demonstrate and discuss his or her medium. We also encourage each member to participate in a friendly monthly competition by bringing a painting of his/her own work to share and be judged by our guest artist (works should be no older than 5 years). At the end of the meeting ribbons are awarded for First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mention, also the attending members will vote for that month's Popular Choice winner. The winners of first place or popular choice awards are then eligible to participate for the Artist of the Year, which is awarded at our holiday event in December.

BAS members exhibit their works at venues throughout the county, providing the ability to share their talents with the public. Members may also link their personal art website to the BAS website at no charge.

Also, the society publishes a monthly e-newsletter called "The Palette", which is available to all on the BAS website. It includes photos of ribbon winning paintings of the previous month, general information regarding membership activities, plus announcements of upcoming art shows. burlingameartsociety.org

Art accepted by the society is limited to two-dimensional works rendered in Oil, Watercolor, Pastel, Pencil, Acrylics, Ink, Mixed Medium and collage. Digital art, pottery, sculpture, jewelry and textiles are not accepted. Artwork submitted for judging must indicate the source of the image, i.e., 1) original, 2) from another artist's work, 3) from a commercially published photograph. It is the artist's responsibility to adhere to applicable copyright laws.
