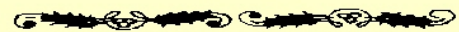
BAS Volunteers

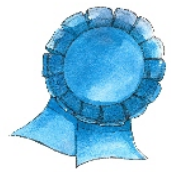
BAS MEMBERSHIP

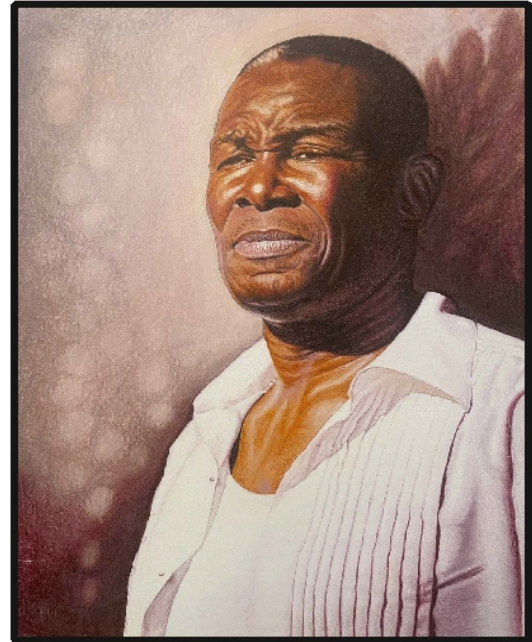

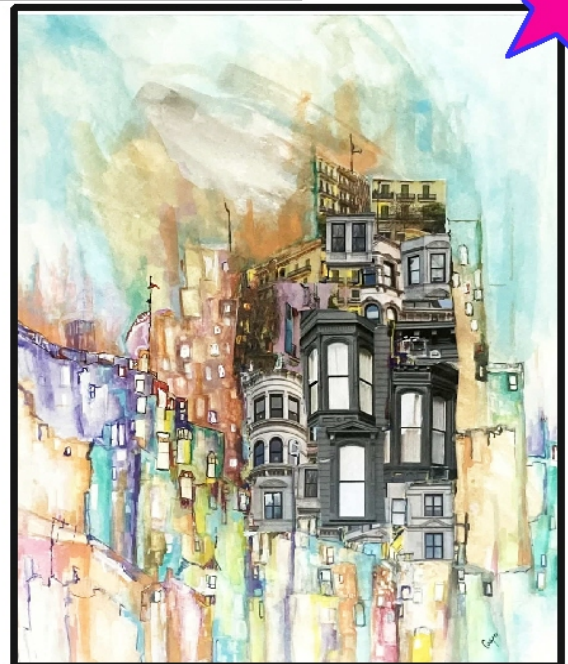

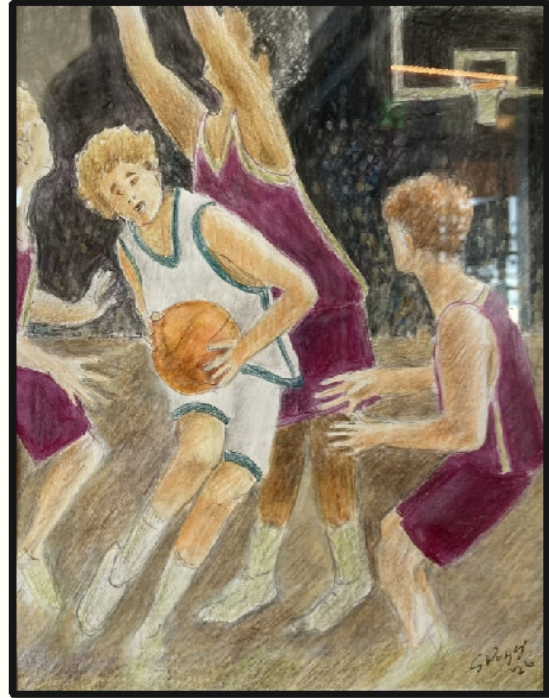
