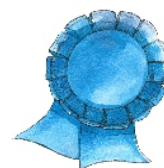
BAS MEMBERSHIP

MEETING RECAP

Our June demo artist, Jean Choe, was quite a treat with her fun and bubbly personality.

Jean is one of those rare artists who really knows how to market herself, or at least she is trying much harder than most. And she was very excited to be doing her first ever demo, although you would have never known. She brought to share with us, some merchandise featuring images of her paintings, which she sells in her online store. Jean was also kind enough to give us a few of the items, which we added as an extra bonus to the afternoon's ribbon winners. Things such as tea towels, aprons, cards and nature-inspired kits to paint. She also demonstrated the technique she uses to create her popular series of paintings that she calls Night Sky. The dreamy atmospheric scenes are painted with layers of watercolor and sprinkled with coarse sea salt while the paint is still damp. The salt is removed only after the paint is completely dry, leaving the star-studded effect of a beautiful night sky.
