History

After several years of reflection and preparation, our first vintage of white wine was born in 2024. This ambitious project was driven by the desire to explore new facets of the terroir and to meet the growing demand for quality white wines. These resistant grape varieties allow us to reduce our environmental impact, a fundamental value of our estate.

Carte Blanche was born, its name referencing an original story of the property. At the beginning of the 20th century, the previous owners lost the estate by going all-in at the casino in Biarritz. These same owners had previously planted plots of white grape varieties, hence the name: Carte Blanche.



Resistant Grape Varieties

A resistant grape variety is **one that has been developed to** fight certain diseases naturally, notably mildew and powdery mildew.

To achieve this, experts use existing grape varieties and cross them with pollen from other vines that are naturally resistant to disease. The result is a resistant grape variety. Resistant grape varieties are therefore not GMOs, but crosses of vines.
