History


An official map dated 1876 shows 76 vineyard plots making up the 30 hectares of Château Lamothe. Today, after an elapse of 130 years, the terroirs are unchanged and Château Lamothe still includes 30 hectares.


But a great terroir is nothing without the talent and the know-how of the winemaker. With the exceptional vintage 2010, there was a unique opportunity to express the best from our terroirs. Vincent FABRE decided in 2010 to create a special blend by selecting the best plots of vines. Thus, he produced a unique Cuvée. Heritage of Lamothe 1876 was born.




Tasting notes


 Deep purple red.

 Aromatic complexity with good integration of fruit and oak. Large spectrum of aromas : cloves, spices and mild tobacco.

 Good structural complexity. Generous and elegant with a long cellaring potential.

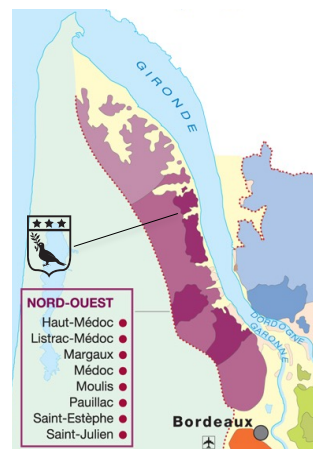

AOC Specifics

The Haut-Médoc appellation stretches some 52 km (37 miles) from north to south. It has terroirs of remarkable quality, with a pre-dominance of layers of (essentially Garonne) gravel, deposited in outcrops, these sites are all characterized by their wide diversity. It is the homeland of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The vines live on since 2000 years thanks to the passion of the winemakers.
