Listed as wine growing estate in 1881, Château Landat was already registered as Cru Bourgeois in 1908 and was famous for producing charming and elegant wines. In the mid-seventies Gabriel Fabre purchased the estate.

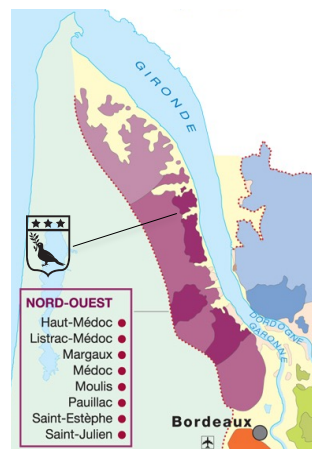

AOC Specifics

The Haut-Médoc appellation stretches some 52 km (37 miles) from north to south. It has terroirs of remarkable quality, with a pre-dominance of layers of (essentially Garonne) gravel, deposited in outcrops, these sites are all characterized by their wide diversity. It is the homeland of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The vines live on since 2000 years thanks to the passion of the winemakers.



A great rich and classic Haut-Médoc with lots of finesse.

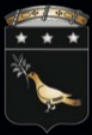

VINTAGE 2021

WINE ENTHUSIAST (03/01/2024) : 91/100 pts *Editors' Choice*

This estate in the north of the Haut-Médoc region has produced a young, still tannic wine that needs aging. It has a ripe turn in its black fruits along with acidity. Drink the wine from 2026. Roger Voss.

VINTAGE 2020

WINE ENTHUSIAST (03/01/2024) : 92/100 pts

The dense tannins and fruits of this rich wine are very promising. Solid blackberry flavors are cut with succulent acidity and a fresh, still very young aftertaste. The wine's structure is still firm and of course needs to soften. Drink this fine wine from 2025.

JAMES SUCKLING : 91/100 pts

Blackberry, cassis, black-tea, oyster-shell and tobacco aromas. It's medium-to full-bodied with firm, powdery tannins. Solid, spiced finish. Try from 2022.
