Can we open up streamside for more light. Can we access a Biodiversity or sewage remediation fund. Do we want to engage with Fresh Water Watch. PhD student Daisy Bell has collected sewage data, and is writing up their dissertation for summer 2025. Now interested in bacterial tests. Luke keen to raise profile of problem. **Kirsty to monitor**

Try to get Tree Team to cut vegetation over pathways round Rec to 2.4m headroom. Its 2.6m when dry and out of leaf. Measure on a wet day when it droops. **Action Jane**

Looking for suggestions for expanding naturalised grasslands in reserve.

Saturday sessions continue. Action Jane to talk to Caroline

Workgroup ends 8 July, restart 2nd September.

Circular walk to be fixed with 4 new posts from Luke and new roundels with QR codes. Action Jane to see how QR roundels are done, Luke to try to source oak posts.

The Ramblers installed 2 new posts on the London Loop

Pavillion storage room decision still awaited.
