



Nanaimo Pickleball Club Play and Inclement Weather Conditions

On days when the club has a session at Oliver Woods and it is questionable as to whether the session should go on due to snow or unsafe driving concerns the following steps should be taken:

- Deb, Lyle, or Gary, upon receiving notice from Parks and Recreation that Oliver Woods will be cancelling their public sessions or closing their venue due to inclement weather - will notify the coordinator of that session and send an email to all members that the session has been cancelled. All members that have signed up for that session, will get a full refund to their account.
- The Executive will try to attempt to send an email in an acceptable amount a time prior to cancelling the session. Members are asked to frequently check their emails if there is a possibility of unsafe driving conditions. Members are encouraged to cancel their registration if they feel at all hesitant about attending a session due to the weather situation. The number of cancellations may determine whether or not the club continues the session. Please do not brave adverse weather for pickleball.
- If Parks and Recreation have not closed their public sessions - the pickleball session will remain open.
- If the coordinator does not feel safe to get to their session on that day, they will need to contact Gary - who will help with finding an alternate coordinator to fill in for that session.
- If a coordinator is unavailable for the session, the session will be cancelled, and the Executive will notify all players, and a full refund will be credited to their account.
- If more than half the signed members cancel, then the session in question will be cancelled, and all signed members will get a full refund to their account. The coordinator will notify one of the mentioned Executives and they will send out a notice to the players that the session has been cancelled.
