

Photographic Gear Checklist

- Masks, plan for one mask per day at least.
- Hand sanitizer .
- Disinfectant wipes.
- Non-Deet insect repellent , to avoid damage of plastic camera equipment.
- Sturdy tripod with head ball or gimbal type head.
- 300 mm lens or longer focal lens. Lenses with shorter focal length than 300 mm will be very likely insufficient for bird or hummingbird photography.
- Teleconverter, preferably 1.4 type for better results.
- Macro lens, if you want.
- DSLR or mirrorless camera.
- Two batteries per camera with charger.
- At least 2 memory cards per camera , 3 is better.
- Flash.
- Rechargeable batteries to use in the flash , at least 2 sets. One in use while the other set is being charged. 3 sets even better when very intense flash use is needed.
- Battery charger for flash batteries.
- Flash bracket.
- Off-camera flash cable.
- Flash extender . IE Beater Beamer or similar , in photographic stores look under flash extenders.
- Transparent plastic bag to cover lens and camera in case of rain.
- Laptop with its charger.
- Card reader.
- Two external hard drives to backup images.
