

Narcissistic Consciousness and Parasitic Behavior

Petty, delusional, entitled narcissists are loud, chaotic, dysfunctional parasitic beings. They project their unresolved burdens onto others, demand attention, reactions, bait debates, instigate drama, play the victim, and drain energy, jumping from one depleted soul to the next.

Narcissists avoid accountability because it threatens their delusional egoic identities, curated moral facades, belief systems, and dysfunctional behavioral patterns. Accountability would collapse the illusion.

They will do anything to climb the ladder of illusion, seeking power, control, status, and resource hoarding while demanding obedience, submission, subservience, and codependency from others who they want dependent on their approval and attention.

But when narcissists encounter someone who is not a pushover, not a people-pleaser, and refuses to tolerate their BS, someone who embodies sovereignty, authenticity, strength, and clear assertive boundaries, the illusion collapses.

When they are denied access to a sovereign soul's sacred energy, their curated identities unravel. Their lies, gossip, fears, prideful ignorance, arrogance, manipulative emotional binding games, passive aggression, and gaslighting narratives crumble.

They are left alone with their own darkness. Forced to sit with their own petty, miserable, mediocre self-deception. Confronting their self-betrayal, emotional stagnation, and fragmented survival-based identity.

Narcissists worship status, money, rank, titles, and false hierarchical authority. They cling to curated identities and surface-level egoic attachments. But when all of that is stripped away, what remains is their true substance, or lack thereof:

Dysfunctional intentions

Self-serving delusional narratives

Avoidance of emotional and spiritual growth
