

# **False Authority and the Architecture of Obedience in a Narcissistic Parasitic Society**

## **The Mechanism of Control**

People are reduced to commodities, numbers, identities, roles, and properties of parasitic systems, governments, corporations, institutions, sitting atop hollow thrones built on illusion rather than truth.

These systems attach on the collective invisible strings of dependency:

- Fear of punishment
- Fear of exclusion
- Fear of instability
- Fear of standing alone

Control is maintained to legitimize unresolved unworthiness, pain, trauma, and the fear of insignificance.

## **Institutions as Engines of Enslavement**

Grandiose institutions of governance, coercion, and control are created to dictate, define, measure, and exploit the collective.

Through debt-based economies, speculative finance, corrupt health profit-based commodified systems, indoctrinated curated education, distorted and corrupt religion stories, and corporate domination, the collective is bound into cycles of dependence, submission, enslavement.
