

A Society That Cannot Govern Itself Seeks Rulers to Validate Its Lack of Self-Sufficiency and Accountability

Those who question are labeled disruptive, dangerous, a threat to the corrupt, soulless, parasitic, narcissistic, false authority curated figures, and their oppressive, coercing, tyrannical, and oligarchical, greedy, hollow, exploitative, enslaving systems.

Those who withdraw consent are framed as threats to the herd's comfort, complacency, and subservience to the corrupt hollow establishment. Those who remember their inner authority are quietly resented and envied because they expose the parasitic, distorted status quo societal illusion.
