

How Fear, Herd Consent, and False Authority Sustain a Hollow, Subservient, Dependent Society

This is a delusional society that is submissive, reliant, and codependent on curated gurus, masters, specialists, titles, and degrees across science, religion, politics, economics, education, corporations, and governance.

While the herd polices, monitors, surveils, reports, compares, competes, and fights each other, consumed by prideful, entitled ignorance and fear, it seeks praise and reward from the very same parasitic people and systems that exploit and enslave it. Rather than stepping up to take accountability for intentions, emotions, actions, choices, and inner work, the herd seeks comfort in self-victimized, petty, bitter, egoic, low-consciousness parasitic mindsets, celebrating self-misery, mediocrity, self-deception, and self-betrayal while blaming, complaining, judging, and demanding more laws, rules, norms, and policies from the systems that oppress them.

Through refusal to embody spontaneity, genuineness, authenticity, compassion, assertiveness, sovereignty, truth, integrity, honor, dignity, responsibility, and accountability for one's inner world.

A parasitic, entitled, dysfunctional society strives to commodify everything and everyone, rooted in deep unresolved emotional trauma, scarcity and poverty mindsets, fear of irrelevance, insignificance, and unworthiness. It speculates, regulates, lies, deceives, manipulates, and scams to leech as a parasite on others for energy, resources, knowledge, wisdom, attention, obedience, compliance, and subservience.

It creates walls of ignorance and fear between state and people, constructing frameworks of approval, authority, and governance perceived as essential and necessary to mislead, enforce, dictate, and coerce communities.

This is how spiritually impoverished a society becomes when it allows itself to be consumed by fear, pride, narcissism, parasitism, and entitled ignorance, where ownership is defined by money, power, and authority, and others are expected to be compliant, obedient, subservient, submissive, and comfortable with being exploited and enslaved.

Parasitic, hollow people and systems of oppression survive only through the agreement, consent, and complacency of a herd that lacks the courage, strength, discernment, and commitment to liberate itself from conditioning, remembering its true essence, soul identity, and refusing to compromise inner peace, self-sufficiency, self-validation, self-worth, authentic sovereign truth, and integrity for anyone or anything.
