Domination persists where self-trust, self-sufficiency, self-validation, and self-acceptance have been replaced by obedience and subservience.

Parasitic people and structures expand only when souls forget that no external framework can define, grant, measure, authorize, or contain their authentic sovereign inherent essence. Sovereignty is not something to be earned, granted, or fought for. It is remembered.

The moment a soul turns inward, reclaiming responsibility for its inner world perceptions, choices, boundaries, and energy, the illusion is exposed and starts to fade, collapse. Not through rebellion. Not through force. But through energetic withdrawal and consent.
