The moment an individual withdraws from the curated theater of blame and turns inward with radical honesty, integrity, compassion, forgiveness, and acceptance the parasitic narcissistic dynamic begins to dissipate, fade from an individual energetic field.

Self-responsibility is not punishment as self-victimized individuals and collective so dearly and desperately try to paint it. It is the exit door.
