

The Hollow Curated Fragmented Facades of a Spiritually Impoverished Narcissistic Society

A narcissistic, parasitic hollow individual and collective intention toward others is carefully curated through fragmented, dishonest, deceptive, and manipulative performative moral hypocritical facades. They hide behind plastic hollow smiles, superficial politeness, manipulative charm, and hypocritical courtesy, while behind these hollow, curated, fake, fragmented false masks lies constant calculation. Measuring. Analyzing. Probing. Enduring Transactional hollow intentional conscious and unconscious self-serving dynamics to perpetuate dependency, obedience, and subservience of others.

Striving to harvest as much information as possible from another being, through intrusive questioning, gossip, emotional probing, or subtle psychological parasitic manipulation. These behaviors serve the purpose of gaining leverage, satisfying petty egoic cravings for superiority, validation, hierarchy, authority, and normalizing control over other beings.

This parasitic, corrupt, low consciousness hollow dynamic manifests in everyday behaviors such as:

- pretending to support someone while secretly resenting their growth or success
- extracting personal information only to later weaponize it through gossip or manipulation
- forming alliances based on opportunism rather than a genuine, authentic connection
- flattery used as a transactional tool to gain influence, status, or advantage
- passive-aggressive sabotage of individuals who express authenticity or independence
- Emotional shaming and guilt-tripping are used to maintain control within relationships
- hierarchical bullying disguised as “leadership,” “mentorship,” or “guidance.”

These parasitic societal behaviors arise from deeply insecure and unintegrated egos, fragmented identities constructed to survive through deception rather than authenticity.

In this hollow parasitic societal environment, fear, pride, ignorance, scarcity, unworthiness, and dependency consume individuals and the collective. The Many become attached to self-victimization while clinging to surface-level egoic addictions, obsessions, possessions, self-sabotaging, clinging to performative identities, and deceptive facades.

By choice, they perpetuate cycles of karmic judgment driven by unresolved trauma and unconscious behavioral and belief toxic patterns.

At both the individual and collective level, the lack of empathy, compassion, genuine intention, authentic sovereign self-expression, and self-accountability becomes normalized, institutionalized, and culturalized through patterns of self-abandonment and self-betrayal.

These dynamics sustain a hollow, soulless, corrupt oligarchical hierarchical authoritarian status quo that rewards obedience, compliance, subservience, and submission to false authority figures and corrupt, deceptive systems of governance, corporation, surveillance, and control.

Indoctrination serves as a tool to shape the perception of the societal herd beliefs and habits landscape through curated ideologies, dogmas, cultural paradigms, traditions, and selectively interpreted scientific narratives. These stories legitimize and protect corrupt networks of influence operated by small groups, hollow clubs that remain hidden in the shadows, pulling the strings of the “puppet masters” in the public theatre.

Through lobbying, financial influence, manipulation of media narratives, and institutional coercion, oppression, punishment, and enforcement, they shape public perception and societal direction.

Meanwhile, the many remain distracted, complacent, comfortable with being dominated and exploited, distracted through entertainment, polarization, consumption, comparison, social competition, digital validation, immersed in chaos and the drama rehearsals by the false authorities who strategically generate diversions, conflicts, dividing public opinion and perception to sustain the parasitical hollow soulless illusions of power, and authority over another.

These illusions and distractions benefit those who accumulate power and wealth while the majority remain spiritually disconnected, complacent, ignorant, and dependent on people and systems that exploit their labor and attention.

Corporate hierarchies, institutional power structures, and political systems reinforce these hollow, low consciousness parasitic dynamics by concentrating power and wealth at the top of the Ponzi status quo while distributing only the minimal benefits to the many, breadcrumbs for the many to fight for amongst each other.

Many receive breadcrumbs, while bosses, managers, executives, gurus, and curated false authority figures, and institutional corrupt elite clubs bask in accumulation, hoarding, oligarchical status, and influence.

But beneath these narcissistic, parasitic, hypocritical moral facades, performances, lies the same hollowness, terrified fear of insignificance and irrelevance in others lives.

Self-misery. Self-mediocrity. Self-serving greed.

These structures depend on ensuring that the many remain obedient, compliant, submissive, and psychologically and emotionally dependent on the illusion of authority, the middleman” figures that manage and define the identity of another being.

It becomes a rehearsal, a performative circus for false authority to perpetuate fear, conflict, dependency, and control the societal narrative.

A hollow theatre of titles, ranks, badges, and symbolic illusions of power.

A hollow show performed by individuals who lack self-honesty, humility, integrity, dignity, self-respect, self-sufficiency, self-love, self-compassion, empathy, healing, and inner integration.

Rather than facing themselves, they attempt to control others.

Rather than healing their fragmentation, they seek to oppress and dominate others.

Rather than cultivating inner emotional and spiritual maturity, they perform to maintain the binding parasitic, distorted, and dysfunctional illusion of superiority.

But the self-victimized herd also shares responsibility, because exploitation persists not only through domination from the ranks, from the “puppet masters”, but through passive and active participation from the ones below the Ponzi status quo societal hollow landscape.

Many agree. Many consent. Many comply.

Playing the victim role while simultaneously feeding the system through obedience, labor, policing each other, and psychological submission to intermediaries, supervisors, managers, gurus, masters, all the perceived false authorities disseminated at all levels of a desolated, spiritually impoverished society.

The “middle man” becomes the gatekeeper of survival. Someone perceived as superior. Someone worthy to please. Someone whose approval becomes necessary and is sought.

Not out of truth, but out of fear. Fear of exclusion. Fear of poverty. Fear of rejection. Fear of losing access to the survival hollow club.

So many strive to be accepted into the hollow ranks of performative authority, the elite hollow club of those who have already compromised their authenticity in exchange for status within the very system that perpetuates individual as collective spiritual impoverishment and spiritual ignorance.

The narcissistic parasitic societal system does not merely survive through deception and manipulation. It survives because too many people prefer the comfort of submission, self-abandonment, and self-betrayal over the responsibility of self-awareness and accountability for one’s own inner state.

Hollow authority can only persist where individuals abandon their inner authority. The moment a human being stops performing, stops appeasing, stops kneeling before titles, ranks, hierarchies, and curated power hollow structures, the illusion weakens.

No parasitic system can dominate a society composed of individuals who cultivate self-honesty, self-regulation, integrity, and sovereign inner discernment.
