

The Puppet Masters and the Self-Victimized Herd Fear-Based Narcissistic Dynamics in a Distorted Parasitic Society

Individuals abandon and betray their authentic selves in order to be seen, acknowledged, recognized, and accepted within the distorted hierarchy of a dysfunctional “elite” class, a spiritually desolated club driven by greed, deception, corruption, insecurity, and fragile, insecure egos hiding behind carefully crafted illusions of narcissistic parasitic superiority.

Within this hollow societal landscape, systems of control, governance, finance, politics, religion, education, and institutional perceived authority are quietly curated in secrecy by small groups of spiritually impoverished parasitic beings and their loyal and submissive “minions” who make sure that the plan is executed at all levels of society.

Unable to cultivate self-sufficiency, self-reliance, self-regulation, or inner accountability, these individuals attempt to harvest the life-force of others through labor, taxes, subscriptions, binding fees, and bureaucratic hollow subservience and dependency designed to keep populations financially, psychologically, and emotionally reliant on the validation and permission of the “puppet masters.”

The system infantilizes the population. Individuals are treated like toddlers. They are told what to think. What to say. What to believe. What to obey. What to comply with. What to fear. What to do.

Submission becomes normalized under the authority of hierarchical, corrupt, hypocritical individuals and their soulless structures that demand obedience to corrupt institutions and false authority figures who claim legitimacy through titles, ranks, and bureaucratic hollow oligarchical frameworks.

The parasitic societal system surveils, monitors, polices, coerces, enforces, punishes, and dictates the boundaries of acceptable thought, speech, and behavior.

Questioning is discouraged. Defiance is punished. Truth is censored. Individuals are indoctrinated to seek permission and approval from people and systems before expressing their authentic selves.

They cling to curated identities, roles, beliefs, and habits constructed for survival and belonging, fragmented masks that keep them trapped, bound within systems of external validation.

From birth, individuals are indoctrinated to abandon themselves to belong. Acceptance becomes conditional. Identity becomes attached to symbols:

A flag. A hymn. A nationality. A title. A profession. An institution. An identification number. A language. A culture. A name.

These surface-level societal narcissistic markers of belonging are passed down through generations as unquestioned truths, cultivating polarization, division, and psychological and emotional dependency and subjugation to please and appease others.

Within this framework, individuals willingly diminish themselves to feel seen and valued. They betray their authentic selves to conform to distorted societal metrics of success, prosperity, and recognition, but genuine evolution, prosperity, as individual and collective well-being cannot emerge from fear-based conformity, centralization of power, and control.

They arise from individuals who take responsibility for their own inner state. Individuals who cultivate self-regulation, self-discernment, self-reliance, and self-validation are guided and grounded in their inner compass.

Individuals who refuse to outsource their authority to external figures, institutions, or systems that demand self-abandonment in exchange for belonging are rewarded.

True sovereignty begins when a human being recognizes that their worth, identity, and authority cannot be granted or taken by any external power.
