The illusion of convenience keeps individuals trapped, bound by surface-level addictions, obsessions, and attachments rooted in deep-seated unresolved fear, trauma, insecurity, and scarcity-driven mindsets. Comfort becomes the mental conditioning cage.

At the top of this societal parasitic structure, those in positions of power construct elaborate systems designed to ensure that the “house always wins.”, perpetuating throughout generations.

They operate from inflated, fragile egos, believing themselves as untouchable, superior, and beyond consequence, while demanding submission to their institutions, laws, ideologies, and greedy parasitic narratives.
