

The Curated Fragmented Tyranny of the “Normal” in Spiritually Impoverished Narcissistic Parasitic Hierarchical Hollow Societies

Clinging to prideful, narcissistic, self-inflicted ignorance, driven by a deep, unspoken fear of insignificance and irrelevance, fear of losing control of the hollow narratives it has been imprinting in the societal landscape.

A fragile, curated, fragmented egoic identity addicted to control and domination.

Attached to beliefs, behaviors, unresolved trauma, and unconscious fear-based patterns.

Lacking emotional maturity. Lacking self-regulation. Lacking self-integrity, self-honor, self-dignity, humility, and authentic sovereignty.

So they lie. They deceive. They betray. They plot. They smear. They gaslight. They scapegoat. They hide in secrecy, knowledge, and information from a docile, compliant, obedient, subservient, and submissive herd.

“Authority knows better than you.”

“Compliance is safety.”

“Questioning is rebellion.”

“Fitting in is rewarded.”

“Being different is dangerous.”

Cultural shaming and guilt-tripping paradigms that reward self-serving competition to win at any cost over genuine collaboration and a share of resources.

Domination over genuine, authentic cooperation.

Obedience over self-discernment arising from within each individual.

External validation over inner knowing.

Curating ideologies that normalize exploitation:

Work harder to survive, while others extract, exploit, accumulate, and hoard resources.

Consume more to feel whole.

Compare constantly to feel worthy, to fill the inner emptiness.

Depend on systems that keep you dependent, compliant, powerless, disconnected, subservient, and submissive to external false authority and validation to exist.

Curating dogmas that divide, fragment, and polarize, keeping individuals distracted, reactive, gaslighting, monitoring each other, and disconnected from their own inner authority.

This is how parasitic narcissistic hollow control sustains itself.

Not through force alone, but through belief.

Through conditioning. Through self-abandonment, self-betrayal of an individual who does not know who he truly is. Through unconscious agreement and consent of the majority.
