

The Hierarchical Disorder in Societal Systems That Normalize Self-Betrayal to Sustain False Parasitic Power

To justify itself, it curates fragmented identities, egoic masks layered over masks held together by moral contradiction, hypocrisy, and attachment to beliefs, ideologies, dogmas, and cultural paradigms that reinforce division, conflict, polarization, competition, and comparison.

You can see it everywhere:

- In corporate environments, individuals smile in meetings and behind the scenes plot in secrecy to undermine, gossip, and compete for status, money, and power.
- In social media ecosystems where curated, distorted identities and stories are rewarded, while authenticity is algorithmically censored unless it can be commodified, monetized, profited from, or sensationalized.
- In political hierarchical hollow systems, where narratives are manipulated, truth is distorted, and fear is weaponized to secure the illusion of power and maintain division amongst the majority.
- In toxic compliant enforced workplaces where employees are overworked, underpaid, and kept in cycles of dependency, too exhausted, pressed, disconnected to question the very system they sustain to survive, and exist.
- In financial corrupt parasitic systems where debt becomes a leash, and survival is tied to compliance, and subservience to soulless, insecure, and petty, greedy beings.
- In education indoctrinating systems where obedience and subservience are prioritized over critical thinking, self-sufficiency, self-sovereignty, and conformity is rewarded over authentic self-expression.
- In spiritual spaces where “leaders” position themselves as gatekeepers of truth, wisdom, and higher authority, subtly creating a binding dependency while preaching liberation through spiritual dishonesty and lack of spiritual integrity.

This is not accidental. It is patterned. It is agreed and consented to by the majority. A dysfunctional fear-based scarcity society addicted to surface-level commodified fragmented existence becomes obsessed with what others have, what others do, what others become, while remaining deeply disconnected from itself.

So it projects. It smiles while resenting, tainted by jealousy due to unworthiness. It praises while envying. It gossips, gaslights, scapegoats, and plays the victim, externalizing its internal chaos rather than taking responsibility for its own healing, regulation, integration, and self-awareness.

There is no courage to look inward honestly, because to look inward would expose and dismantle the curated, fragmented identity self-preserving survival illusion.

Instead: People attach to roles. To titles. To status. To egoic identity constructs that offer temporary validation but no real grounding and inner clarity.

So the system rewards:

- Performance over authenticity
- Compliance over truth
- Obedience over Self-discernment
- Status over self-integrity

At scale, this becomes normalized, institutionalized, and legalized.

Human beings are no longer seen as sovereign individuals, but as assets, labor units, data points, and consumers. Commodified. Measured. Tracked. Controlled.

You can see it in:

- Mass Surveillance parasitic greedy soulless capitalism that monetizes attention and behavior.
- Algorithmic propaganda systems that shape perception and reinforce emotional and psychological dependency.
- Labor corrupt structures where time, energy, and creativity are traded for survival.
- Military and corporate hierarchies where individuals follow orders even when it conflicts with their inner knowing and intuitive compass.
- Whistleblowers, truth-speakers, and independent thinkers are being silenced, censored, or discredited.

The message is clear from the corrupt, hollow hierarchical societal systems: Do not question. Do not disrupt. Do not stand alone. Because anyone who refuses to self-betray becomes a threat.
