

# **The Engineered Illusion of Power - How Parasitic False Hierarchies Feed on Self-Betrayal and Collective Attention and Consent**

Those who embrace cunning, connivance, and Ponzi-like strategies are rewarded for being “ahead of the game,” being perceived as more intelligent, more superior, more deserving, more worthy of recognition and imitation.

In this distorted, dysfunctional, self-victimized, hierarchical, narcissistic, profit-based, commodified hollow surface-level society, hoarding money and accumulating status are upheld as the pinnacles of success and authority.

Meanwhile, poverty, scarcity, obedience, subservience, compliance, and submission to the Ponzi-like rank ladder are carefully engineered and normalized to shape collective perception.

The majority becomes conditioned to accept this corrupt, endemic societal soulless, parasitic structure, unconsciously offering their attention and consent, participating in their own disempowerment and diminishment.

They self-abandon. They self-betray. All to belong. All to be granted an identity badge defined by numbers, a nationality, completely dependent on externally imposed labels within a parasitic, manipulative, oligarchical, and exploitative societal system.

A parasitic oppressive system designed to perpetuate fear-based narratives, scarcity-driven paradigms, and deep inner disconnection.

Individuals who cling to self-insecurities, attached to unresolved pain and trauma, willingly support, defend, and cooperate with the very systems that surveil, control, harvest, exploit, and dominate them.

They project and reinforce parasitic, binding, false hierarchical frameworks that feed on subservience and the outsourcing of inner authority and self-regulation. Dependency is rewarded. Compliance is praised. Obedience is normalized, institutionalized, and legalized.

All sustained through curated, fragmented, fear-based middleman ideologies, dogmas, and cultural paradigms that glorify division, conflict, scarcity, fear, and unworthiness, while standardizing and commodifying human life. Within this self-victimized, spiritually impoverished societal structure, false hierarchies and false authority figures position themselves as necessary, superior, and indispensable, while operating from self-serving, parasitic intentions that do not hold the majority's best interest at heart.

They sustain influence through division, conflict, connivance, secrecy, and chaos, feeding on fear, ignorance, and inner disconnection, ensuring individuals remain distracted, dependent, and disconnected from their own inner authority.

Their false hollow power is not inherent; it is sustained through shaping others' perception, reinforced by repetition, indoctrination, disseminated propaganda at all levels of society, and maintained by the participation of those who fear stepping outside the system more than they fear remaining diminished within it.

The system is not only imposed and enforced, but it is defended by a majority attached to curated, fragmented identity self-preserving constructs. With individuals unwilling to confront their own shadows, projecting outward, policing one another, competing, comparing, fighting each other, and reinforcing the very parasitic structures that limit and feed on them.

They resist self-inquiry. They avoid self-honesty. They cling to conditioned identities, beliefs, and narratives that keep them safe within the familiar, even when the familiar is what binds and diminishes them.

So, the cycle perpetuates, not just through those in perceived positions of power, but through the collective agreement and consent of a majority that neglects self-awareness, self-regulation, and self-acceptance, that resists remembering who they are beyond all the layers of conditioning, illusion.

But there is a path that contributes to dissolving all of this, and it does not begin externally; it begins within.

Through radical self-honesty. Through the willingness to sit with discomfort without projection or scapegoating. Through observing your own patterns without distortion or judgment. It requires self-regulation, no longer outsourcing your emotions, your peace, or your true, authentic identity and essence. It calls for self-integration, embracing every fragmented aspect of your being without rejection.

It demands self-acceptance, self-accountability, and the reclamation of your inner authority, and in that remembrance, return, your inner voice becomes clear. Your discernment sharpens. Your presence stabilizes. Your inner intuitive compass exposes the falseness, manipulation, deception, and ill-hearted intentions of others.
