After first appointment:	Scheduling fee	\$45.00	Scheduling fee is applied to ALL appointments and covers travel for the dental hygienist, bookkeeping, record charting, and instrument handling.

			Our services are specialized and space is limited. The scheduling fee is non-refundable if the appointment is canceled less than 48 hours, unless special circumstances.
Dental cleanings are based on the patient's gum and bone health, therefore cost for a dental cleaning ranges.  Here are the different types of professional cleanings:	D1110	\$95.00	Prophylaxis- adult. Removal of plaque, calculus, and stains from the tooth structures in the permanent and transitional dentition. It is intended to control local irrational factors.
	D4346	\$120.00	Scaling in presence of generalized moderate or severe gingival inflammation – full mouth, after oral evaluation.
	D4355	\$165.00	Full mouth debridement to enable a comprehensive periodontal evaluation and diagnosis on a subsequent

			visit.
	D4341	\$130.00	The dental procedure for non-surgical periodontal therapy/SRP of four or more teeth, per quadrant.
	D4342	\$110.00	The dental procedure for non-surgical periodontal therapy/SRP of one to three teeth, per quadrant.
	D4910	\$130.00	Periodontal maintenance
Miscellaneous adjunctive services:	D1354	\$35 per site	Silver Diamine Fluoride (SDF) a interim caries arresting medicament application-per tooth. (Conservative treatment of an active, non-symptomatic carious lesion by topical application.)
	D1206	\$40.00	Topical fluoride varnish-

			Fluoride varnish is made with fluoride, a mineral that can strengthen tooth enamel (outer coating on teeth). It is painted on the top and sides of each tooth. Sticky in nature but hardens once it comes in contact with the saliva.
	D1351	\$45.00 per tooth	Sealants per tooth.
	D1310	\$0.00	Nutritional counseling
	D1320	\$0.00	Tobacco cessation
	D1330	\$0.00	Oral hygiene instructions
Toothbrushing program (alternative to professional dental cleaning)		\$25 a session	Our brush, floss, rinse program is where we meet with the patient 2-3 times a month and do basic oral hygiene care. not tolerate or be ready for a professional cleaning, therefore this program helps build rapport and trust with the patient.
