CONDITIONS

- Entry fees shall be paid at time of entry.
- Entries must be made on attached form or like copy.
- The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, subject to the modification hereafter mentioned and local rules of the Freycinet Golf Club. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee of the Freycinet Golf Club within seven days from the date of such decision. The Executive Committee's decision on the matter shall be final.
- Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Secretary or Captain at the Clubhouse before 6.00pm on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make any alterations in the Handicap Divisions before any event should they deem it advisable.
- In every event the Competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such manner as the Tournament Committee may arrange, and the Tournament Committee or such person as the Tournament Committee may authorize, shall have the power to select a partner for any Competitor whose partner is not at the Tee when called upon at that time appointed to start.
- The Tournament Committee to make all arrangements and have full power to alter or make any variation in the conditions or programme should they deem it advisable.
- All events open to amateurs only, who are members or Registered Clubs of the Northern Tasmanian Golf Association, or who are members of golf clubs affiliated to the Southern Tasmanian Golf Union, or Golf Clubs outside the State of Tasmania and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- Should two or more competitors tie for the 18 Holes Lady Members/ Associated or 18 Holes Members Gross Events, the players concerned in the tie shall play the 8th and 9th holes only until sudden death is reached. Other events shall be decided on count back.
- The Tournament Committee shall have power to limit the number of entries which will be received in any event and to alter the time fixed for starting any event.
- LATE ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED. Apart from scratch events should any player withdraw from any event, including a foursome event—he or she forfeits his or her entry fee and any replacement in a foursome event must pay and entry fee.
