Cesky Terrier

LD/B (1,0)

1. Marett's Foxprims Marble Arch avec Gayteckels. 14 mth bitch showing much promise but at the teenager stage right now. Balanced in outline with excellent neck, typical topline, good length to ribcage and tail of good set and carriage. Feminine head with slight arch to skull, good eye and ear and excellent dentition. Impressed on the move; true on the down and back and with desired brisk, propulsive action. Very well handled.

OD/B (3,0)

1. Marett's Jsy Ch Gayteckels Musical Melody. 5 yr old bitch. Quality girl who appealed for type and presented such a good outline with moderate length of neck, medium length to body with correct topline, excellent ribbing, muscular loin and tail set and carried just right. Quality head and expression with good eye and ear and correct scissor bite. Goes so well on the go around and makes the most of herself. BOB, Group 1 and Best in Show 5.

2. Marett's Gayteckels Bottoms Up Pd'h. This girl turned out to be the dam of the winner and approaching 9 yrs. I pondered hard on placing these two girls but this one, although full of quality, is a smidge longer cast and hence my placement. Otherwise she was a delight. Correct for type, excellent neck, characteristic topline of the breed and good rib and loin. First class head with excellent eye and ear and scissor bite. Quite something on the move and shows herself to the max.

3. Marett's Gayteckels Sister Act Pd'h

Irish Terrier

OB (2,0)

1. Kucza's Amberville No One Like You. These two girls turned out to be 21 mth old litter mates. My winner just had the edge in overall type and outline but otherwise they are very similar. Neck of good length to balance, firm topline, good depth to chest and tail set on well. Very nice head and expression with lovely dark eye, very good ears and correct dentition. Stands true on very good feet and when relaxed she went well on the go around and is true behind. Jacket of good texture. BOB and Group 2.

2. Le Couilliard's Amberville Born to Fly. This girl also appealed for outline with clean neck of good length to balance, straight back, deep brisket, muscular loin and tail set on well. Flat skull of good length, dark expressive eyes, ears set on well and scissor bite. Standing on good feet and firm muscular hindquarters with moderate turn of stifle. Not quite as good on the go around as 1 but cleaner coming towards.

Jack Russell Terrier

OD/B (1,0)

1. McFarlane's Kabu Take It To The Max. 5 yr old dog. Head of sufficient length to balance, firm topline, pleasing rib but would like to see a shorter loin. Flat skull of medium width, keen expression and good dentition. Somewhat wider in front but this doesn't reflect too much when gaiting. Firm rear action and goes well enough on the go around. Fair presentation. Excellent temperament. BOB and Group 4.

Staffordshire Bull Terrier

OD/B (1,0)

1. Fletcher & Seedhouse's Fairlenium Nordic Queen at Granitangel. 3 yr old brindle/white pied bitch. Feminine throughout, this girl was very well handled. Pleasing headpiece with broad skull, dark expressive eyes, well developed cheek muscles, excellent ears, short muzzle and scissor bite. Muscular neck, excellent topline and ribbed well back. She stands well in front with good width and has good angles both ends. Opens up well on the go around. Well handled. BOB and Group 3.

#### AVNSC Terrier

OD/B (1,0)

1. Runacres' Caldbeckjack Lady Pem. 12 mth old Wire Fox Terrier bitch. Rather raw youngster who is in need of a little more ring training. Feminine all through with pleasing neck, short firm back, ribbing still to fully develop and tail set on high but curled. Ears set on well, eyes could be darked to enhance expression, scissor bite. When relaxed she moved well when viewed in profile. Best AVNSC Terrier.

Masculine head with very good skull, ears set on high, expressive eyes and still retaining strong dentition. Pleasing neck, good forechest, fair topline and tail carried well. Goes like a bomb when gaiting and is true when coming and going.

Brace (1,0)

1. Marett's Cesky Terriers. Well matched brace for type, outline and colour and both carrying good bone. They showed very well together assisted by their very capable handlers who moved them at just the right pace.

PD/B (1,0)

1. Rudd & Channing-Rudd's Bedeburn Gan Canny. 7 mth old dog pup who shows much promise. I thought him an excellent type and he carries super bone and substance. Slightly

arched neck of moderate length, firm topline, excellent ribbing for age, muscular loin and tail of good length and carriage. Masculine head of good proportions, moderate stop, expressive eyes, ears set on well and good dentition. Stands true in front and goes so well in profile, when settled. BOB, Best Puppy, Group 3 and Puppy Group 1.

#### Russian Black Terrier

OD/B (2,1)

1. Lynnyk's Zeus Black Legion. 19 mth old dog who impressed for size, bone and outline. Muscular neck, firm level back, good depth to chest, broad loin and tail set on high. Masculine head with moderately broad skull, dark oval-shaped eyes, powerful muzzle and strong dentition. Covers the ground on the go around, powerful hind action but a tad looser coming towards. Coat of good texture with plenty of undercoat. Well handled. BOB, Group 1 and Best in Show 6.

#### AV Imported Breed Register Working

OD/B (1,0)

1. Sharrock's Edison-Eiger vom Rickental. 7 yr old Entlebucher Mountain Dog who has so much to like. He presented a well-balanced outline with muscular neck of moderate length, level back, deep brisket, well-muscled loin and correct tail carriage. Masculine headpiece with flat skull, expressive eyes, ears set on high and correct dentition. Good angles front and rear and impressed on the go around, gaiting with purpose. Best AV Imported Breed Register Working, Group 2 and ended the day by taking Best Veteran in Show.

OD/B (2,1)

1. Bennett's Mayasan of Jasandor. 14 mth old dog. This youngster pleased for overall type and presented a good outline with clean neck of correct length to balance, backline falling

away slightly as desired, deep brisket but obviously still to fully develop, muscular loin and tail good for set and carriage. Pleasing head and expression with good eye and ear, strong muzzle and scissor bite. Moves out well in profile but could be firmer behind. BOB and Group 3.

#### Welsh Corgi (Cardigan)

OD/B (1,0)

1. Marett's Twinan Lets Be A Clown at Gayteckels. 2 yr old brindle bitch. Feminine all through and appealed for overall type and outline. Muscular neck of correct length to give balance, firm topline, excellent ribbing and loin and tail correct for length. Skull showing width between her correctly set ears which are of good size, eyes of good colour but corners could be more defined, muzzle of correct length and scissor bite. Good rear angulation and well muscled all through. Moves out with drive. BOB and Group 2.

#### Welsh Corgi (Pembroke)

OD/B (1,0)

1. Beaumont & Bisson's Woodhenge Stars In Your Eyes for Beaulamey. 2 yr old bitch who is feminine throughout and was pleasing to go over. Neck of good length to balance, pretty good in topline, good depth to brisket, correct ribbing and full tail with pleasing carriage. Attractive head of good proportions, eyes of good colour, correct set on of ears, tapering muzzle and scissor bite. She stands true on good feet with correct forechest. Gaits true both fore and aft and moved out well on the go around. BOB, Group 1 and Best in Show 7.

Pleasing outline with well arched neck of correct length, ribbed well back and rib developing as it should, short in the couplings and tail set on high and of good carriage. Most attractive head, full of femininity, correctly proportioned, excellent eye and good dentition. Super profile action and carriage and true when coming towards. Very good coat for age. Best Puppy, Puppy Group 1 and ended the day by taking Best Puppy in Show.

OB (1,0)

1. Walker & Journeaux's Jsy Ch Petwalk Inspirational. 3 yr old pale gold bitch. Quality girl who was presented to perfection here. Well balanced and feminine throughout. Well arched neck, correct ribbing, strong loin and tail set on high and carried well over the back as desired. Super head and expression with the best of eyes, moderately narrow in skull, pendant ears, medium stop, muzzle of correct length to balance and excellent dentition.

Good angles front and rear and has excellent action all through. So very well handled. BOB, Group 3 and Best in Show 3.

#### Shih Tzu

PD/B (1,0)

1. Cooper's Shenleyvale Orange Fantasy with Forepaws. 6 mth old gold dog. Very much a baby but he pleased for type and carries ample bone. Most attractive head and expression with good breadth to skull, dark round eyes which are placed well apart, defined stop, wide open nostrils and good underjaw. Neck of correct length, topline to settle, ribcage extends well back and tail set on ok. Moves well on the go around and shows full pad when going away. Best Puppy and Puppy Group 2.

LD/B (2,0)

1. Stewart-Smith's Forepaws Fury for Imenso. 3 yr old gold/white dog. Correct length of neck to balance, good length to ribcage, short in the couplings and heavily plumed tail set on high and of good carriage. Attractive head with breadth to skull, expressive eyes of good size, colour and placement, wide open nostrils and good underjaw. When gaiting he goes well when viewed in profile and shows a full pad. Would just like a tad more breadth in front. BOB and Group 3.

1. Whitehead, Selby & Hannigan's Zilcan Black Magic. 2 yr old black bitch. I thought this girl an excellent type and she is so very well balanced. Muscular neck of moderate length, deep brisket, ribbing extending well back, well-muscled loin and tail correct for set and carriage. Feminine headpiece with excellent skull, expressive eyes of good colour, muzzle of correct length to balance and good dentition. Pleasing angles front and rear and goes so well on the go around with confident carriage and very good when going away. Coat of correct texture and well presented. BOB and Group 2.

1. Oliver's Glynfelin Regal Fontaine. 3 yr old fawn French Bulldog bitch. A tad refined for me but she is feminine throughout and has a neck of correct length, pretty good topline, short loin and pleasing rump. Excellent ears for size and set, dark round expressive eyes, good nostrils. She stands on good feet and moved well when viewed in profile with good carriage. Well handled. Best AVNSC Utility and Group 4.

1. Moulin's Gunsyn Supertrooper Sur Majikisles. 6 mth old white/orange dog. Promising youngster who appealed for overall type and outline. Powerful neck, correct topline of the breed, short in the couplings and tail of correct carriage. Pleasing head and expression with divergent planes, ears of correct set, oval-shaped eyes, good depth to muzzle and scissor bite. Stands on excellent feet, moving true both fore and aft and opens up well on the go around. Best Puppy, Puppy Group 1 and ended the day by taking Reserve Best Puppy in Show.

OD/B (1,0)

1. Moulin's Gunsyn Ginontherock Dei Majikisles. 4 yr old white/orange bitch with so much to like. Feminine throughout, she presented a lovely outline with neck of correct length to balance, firm topline, good depth to chest, super ribbing and tail good for set and carriage. Attractive head with divergent planes, expressive oval-shaped eyes, ears set on just right, slight stop and correct dentition. Certainly didn't disappoint when gaitting and covered the ground with good carriage. BOB, Group 1 and Best in Show 4.

German Shorthaired Pointer

OD/B (2,0)

1. Vidamour's Richtig Razzle Me Pink. Two very different exhibits challenged here. My winner was this 17 mth old bitch. She is still some way from maturity but she has plenty to like. Slightly arched neck of correct length, firm topline, chest still to drop, muscular loin, correct croup and tail carried as desired. Nicely proportioned head with expressive eyes, ears set on high and scissor bite. She stands straight in front on very good feet and has pleasing angles both ends. Moving freely all through. BOB.

2. Michel's Kavacanne Orzo. 4 yr old dog, Mature lad with good muscle-tone throughout. Neck of correct length to give balance, firm topline, deep brisket, good breadth to loin but not quite croup or tail carriage of winner. Quite different in head to 1, being somewhat deep in muzzle but pleasing eye and ear and good dentition. Moves cleanly on the down and back and was so very well handled here.

Gordon Setter

OD/B (1,0)

1. Parkin's Magnalodge Loch Maree. 2 yr old bitch who pleased for type and presented a nice outline with clean neck of good length, firm level topline, deep brisket and tail of good carriage. Feminine headpiece with very nice eye, ears set low, correct planes and scissor bite. She stands true in front on well arched toes and has good angles both ends. On the go around, she opens up well but would like to see a tad more breadth in front. Very well handled. BOB.

Irish Setter

OD/B (1,0)

1. Cox's Tiroen The Sky's The Limit. 17 mth old bitch showing much promise but as you would expect, she has plenty of maturing to do. I thought her very good for overall type, she is so very feminine and presented a lovely outline. Slightly arched neck, firm topline, good depth to chest and tail good for set and carriage. Quality head of good length, lean as

desired, best of eyes, ears set on low and good dentition. Straight forelegs, excellent feet and good turn of stifle. When settled went well on the go around. BOB, Group 4 and ended the day by taking Reserve Best Junior in Show.

#### Retriever (Golden)

PD/B (1,0)

1. Rondel's Astleyfold Snowy Saffron. 10 mth old bitch. Feminine all through and pleasing for type. Good length of neck, firm in topline, good depth of brisket and rib developing well for age. Balanced headpiece with breadth to skull, dark expressive eyes, well defined stop and good dentition. Standing on cat-like feet and with pleasing forechest. Moving pretty well on the go around but tail carried a little higher. BOB, Best Puppy and Puppy Group 3.

#### Spaniel (American Cocker)

OD/B (1,0)

1. Houghton's Alabama No Joke at Fielgar. 2 yr old black dog who was so good to go over given his correct construction. He presented a compact outline with neck of good length, firm topline with slight slope from withers to croup, excellent ribbing, short in the couplings and tail good for set and carriage. Attractive head of good proportions, distinct stop, expressive eyes, ears of correct set and good dentition. Well developed forechest and stands true in front. Gaïting freely all through but could use himself more to advantage. BOB and Group 3.

#### Spaniel (Cocker)

PD/B (1,0)

1. Le Masurier's Topday Could It Be Magic. 10 mth old blue roan dog who was absolutely full of it on the day and is need of some more ring training. Moderate length of neck, firm topline and rib developing well for age. Well-proportioned head with masculine expression, expressive eyes, ears set on low and scissor bite. Carrying good bone, standing straight in front and with a well-turned stifle. Movement was somewhat difficult to assess. Best Puppy and Puppy Group 2.

LD/B (2,0)

1. Kezourec's Wilmerella Fantasy at Belcroute. 20 mth old blue roan bitch. Very nice young bitch who was a comfortable winner in this class for me. She pleased for type, is full of femininity and presented a very nice outline. Muscular neck of correct length to balance, good backline, excellent ribbing, short in the couplings and tail of correct carriage. Most attractive head and expression, good eye and ear, clean through the cheeks and good dentition. Good angles front and rear and scored here on the go around.

2. White's Granrose Tantrums N'Tiaras. 20 mth old black/white bitch presented in super coat and condition. Neck of moderate length but not quite the flow into shoulder of winner, firm topline, ribbed well back, nice short loin and tail of good carriage. Attractive head of good proportions, lovely eye and ear, good chiselling and scissor bite. Muscular hindquarters with nice turn of stifle. Not quite profile action of 1.

OB (2,0)

1. White's Jsy Ch Granrose Blue Topaz. 3 yr old blue roan bitch. Quality girl who appealed for type, carries good bone and is very well constructed. Muscular neck of correct length to provide balance, firm topline with slight slope as desired, well sprung ribs, short in the couplings and tail of correct carriage. Very nice head and expression, good skull to muzzle proportions, dark eyes, ears set on low and scissor bite. Good angles front and rear,

standing true in front and moved out freely with good carriage. Excellent coat. BOB and Group 2.

2. White's Granrose Blue Sapphire. 6 yr old blue roan bitch, out of a larger mould than the winner. Neck of moderate length, pleasing topline, deep brisket, ribbed well back, short muscular loin and tail carried correctly. Feminine headpiece with good skull to muzzle proportions, ears set on low and scissor bite but overall preferred expression of 1. She is well boned and stands on cat-like feet. Moving pretty well all through but winner stood out for me.

Spaniel (Welsh Springer)

OD/B (1,0)

1. Carre's Kamunting Andy's Rex. 4 yr old dog. Soundly constructed lad with a super temperament. Pleasing outline with clean neck of good length, firm topline, deep brisket and muscular loin. Masculine headpiece with slight dome to skull, eyes blend with coat, ears set on moderately low, medium length of muzzle and correct dentition. Carrying good bone, he stands true in front on excellent feet and is well-muscled all through. When gaiting he really opens up well on the go around but tail carried a tad higher. BOB.

1. White's Granrose Sapphire Design. 9 yr old blue roan Cocker Spaniel bitch. She appealed for overall type and outline and was shown here in super condition. Clean neck of moderate length, firm topline, well sprung ribs, short muscular loin and tail pleased for both set and carriage. Feminine head with dark expressive eyes, ears set on low and excellent dentition. Gaiting true when coming and going but could open up a tad more on the go around. Tail never stops so unmistakably a 'Merry Cocker'!

2. Houghton's Fielgar Flyin The Flag. 9 yr old American Cocker Spaniel dog who I wouldn't want any bigger. Neck of good length, correct topline, deep brisket and tail of good carriage.



Expressive dark eyes, ears of correct set and defined stop. Moving out pretty well on the go around and nice and true when going away but could be more positive in front. Good coat and well handled.

#### Brace (2,0)

1. White's Spaniel (Cocker). Two sets of well-matched brace competed here, both so similar for overall type and size and moving very well together, but the nod went to the Cockers.

##### LD/B (1,0)

1. McFarlane & Routledge's Pufflepaws Phools Prophecy. 19 mth old powderpuff dog. Lean neck of sufficient length, ribbed well back and tail set on high. Balanced headpiece with expressive almond-shaped eyes and good dentition. He stands true in front and impressed when coming towards and gaited pretty well on the go around.

##### OD (2,0)

1. Walker's Solino's The Entertainer for Petwalk (Imp Hun). Showy 2 yr old hairless dog who was good to go over. Excellent neck, firm level back, moderate tuck-up and tail good for set and carriage. Eyes of good colour and very good dentition but not quite expression I was looking for. Well constructed front and rear and he moved freely when viewed from all angles. Fine skin and very well presented.
2. McFarlane's Sharanae Liquid Gold TAF. 6 yr old powderpuff dog. Somewhat longer cast but he has a good neck and is nice and firm in topline. Dark expressive eyes, large ears of good set and correct mouth. Gaiting very well on the go around and true when going away, somewhat wider when coming at you.

##### OB (2,0)

1. Walker's Petwalk Naked Attraction. 13 mth old hairless bitch. Quality girl who very much appealed for type and outline. Lean neck of good length to balance, excellent topline, good length to ribcage and tail just right for set and carriage. Feminine headpiece of good proportions, the best of eyes and ears and good dentition. Correct angles front and rear, standing on characteristic feet and moved out freely with excellent carriage. Very good skin and conditioning. BOB, Group 2, Best Junior in Show and Best Novice in Show.
2. McFarlane's Zerachiel Exotic Dancer ShCM. 13 yr old hairless bitch. This girl certainly looks nowhere near her age and was presented in very good condition. Balanced outline with pleasing neck, level back and correct ribbing. Very nice head proportions with lovely eye and ear. Standing straight in front on correct feet and moved true on the down and back but not quite profile action of winner.

#### Chihuahua (Smooth Coat)

##### OD/B (1,0)

1. Schofield's Beaulamey A Gift for Rudoli. 4 yr old fawn bitch who pleased for overall type and outline. Moderate length of neck, level topline, nice spring of rib and sickle tail. Feminine head with good eyes for size and placement and ears set on well. She stands nice and straight in front on excellent feet, gaiting well in profile and pretty good on the down and back. BOB.

#### Griffon Bruxellois

## OD/B (2,0)

1. Hannigan & Maloret's Zilcan Aelia. 3 yr old red smooth bitch. This girl is a smidge longer than the ideal but otherwise she very much appealed. Slightly arched neck, firm topline and very good ribbing. Attractive head with feminine expression; rounded skull, lovely eye and ear and good upturn to jaw. Good angles both ends and stands straight in front. Moves well all through, just a shame she lacks confidence. BOB.

2. Whitehead, Selby & Hannigan's Zilcan Gangster Man. 3 yr old red rough dog. This boy pleased for type and is nice and cobby but I would just like to see a tad more length of neck to balance. Rounded skull, excellent eye and ear and wide open nostrils. Pleasing front angulation, good width to chest and stands true on cat-like feet. Moving ok on the go around but closer behind than preferred. Very good coat and presentation.

## Papillon

### OD/B (1,0)

1. Stewart-Smith, Church, Church & Cooper's Forepaws Dutch Courage for Invanse. 3 yr old tricolour dog who made the most of himself at all times and was presented in super coat and condition. Well balanced with moderate length of neck, firm level topline, ribbing carried well back and tail set on high and of good carriage. Attractive head with excellent eye and ear, finely pointed muzzle and correct dentition. He stands true on characteristic feet and goes so well on the go around with confident carriage. Very well handled. BOB, Group 1 and finally ended the day by taking Reserve Best in Show.

## Japanese Chin

### OD (1,0)

1. McFarlane's Jeskandai Koi No Yokan ShCEx. Black/white dog approaching 6 yrs who has plenty to like. He pleased for outline with moderate length of neck, firm topline, well ribbed back and tail set on high. Nicely marked head with eyes showing white as desired and short muzzle of good width. Pleasing angles and moved out well when viewed in profile. BOB.

## Pekingese

### OD/B (1,0)

1. Michel's Pekehuis Dream Time of Ksarina. 2 yr old dog who appealed for type and carries very good bone. Pleasing breadth to skull, and round eyes of good size and colour, wide open nostrils and well defined chin, however would like less over-nose wrinkle. He has good breadth in front, correct length of neck and firm level topline. Moving steadily and pleased both fore and aft. Good texture to coat. BOB.

1. McFarlane's Kerryken Keir Rob. 5 yr old dog who really did appeal and was good to go over. Strongly built, of good type, and presenting a nicely balanced outline. Neck of good length, firm topline, excellent ribbing, nice short loin and tail good for set and carriage. Masculine head of good proportions with breadth to skull, expressive eyes and good dentition. Soundly constructed all through, moving freely and using himself as he goes. BOB and Group 3.

ground with characteristic springy action. Good coat and presentation. BOB, Group 2 and Best Yearling in Show.

2. Hannigan & Maloret's Ch Brigitte Bardot Gandamak for Zobear. 6 yr old bitch who turned out to be the dam of the winner. She too pleased for length of neck, topline and tail set and carriage but she doesn't quite have the balance of her daughter. Attractive head with pleasing expression; nice dark eyes, ears set on low, good length to muzzle and scissor bite. On the go around she extends well but doesn't quite have the springy gait of winner.

#### Dachshund (Min Smooth-Haired)

OD/B (1,0)

1. Coleman's Steeledax Mars. 20 mth old chocolate/tan bitch who pleased in outline with slightly arched neck, firm topline with ribbing carried well back and tail good for set and carriage. Feminine head with eyes of good colour but a tad rounder than preferred, ears of correct set and good dentition. Moving out well on the go around, moving parallel when going away and ok coming towards. BOB and Group 3.

#### Whippet

LD (4,0)

1. Mottershaw's Eeri Whiter Shade of Pale for Elangeni. 2 yr old dog who was a comfortable winner in this class for me. He pleased in outline with neck of good length, has nice depth to chest, correct arch over the loin and tail good for both set and carriage. Pleasing head with good length, expressive eyes of good colour, rose-shaped ears and scissor bite. He stands straight in front on oval-shaped feet and scored in this class with his profile action.

2. Lawson's Kipipiriking Silver Shadow. 4 yr old dog who was pleasing to go over. Neck of good length, good depth to brisket, arch over the loin and tail set on low. Balanced head with masculine expression; skull flat on top, width between the eyes, very good ears and scissor bite. Moves ok all through but could not compete with winner on the go around.

3. Lawson's Kipipiriking Blue Bandana

LB (3,0)

1. Lawson's Kipipiriking Magic De Noel. Varied class which saw this 23 mth old bitch come out on top. Neck of good length, pleasing rib but could have more depth to brisket, arch over the loin and tail good for both set and carriage. Well proportioned head with feminine expression; good eyes for colour and placement, rose-shaped ears and correct dentition. Stands nice and straight in front on good feet and opened up well enough when viewed in profile.

2. Officer's Eeri Thanks For The Dance. 2 yr old bitch who has plenty to like but just felt she was a little heavy all through especially for a bitch and she isn't quite as good in topline as winner. Excellent neck, good depth to chest, muscular loin and tail set on low. Attractive head and expression with good eye and ear and scissor bite. Pleasing angles front and rear and stands well naturally.

3. Lawson's Kipipiriking Luna May

OD (2,0)

1. Mottershaw's Eeri Come Fly With Me to Elangeni. 4 yr old dog who pleased in outline with muscular neck of good length to balance, chest of good depth, nice spring of rib, arch over the loin and tail good for set and carriage. Head of good proportions with masculine expression; nice dark eyes, correct ears, powerful jaws and scissor bite. Straight forelegs, correct feet and super hind angulation. Gaing well enough on the go around.

2. Lawson's Alamayn Equinox Cassidy. 10 yr old dog shown here in super nick. A little longer cast than preferred but he has a good length of neck, deep brisket, more length to loin and tail set and carried correctly. Pleasing headpiece with lovely eye and ear and slight stop. Shoulder well laid back and stands straight on excellent feet. Really opens up well when viewed in profile.

#### OB (2,0)

1. Walker's Silkridge Jean Genie for Petwalk. 2 yr old bitch who turned out to be the star of the day. Full of quality, she greatly appealed for type and presented a super balanced outline with elegantly arched neck of good length, excellent depth to chest, correct ribbing, graceful arch over the loin, correct underline and tail just right for length, set and carriage. Beautiful headpiece of correct proportions, alert oval-shaped eyes of good colour, excellent ears, slight stop and scissor bite. Soundly constructed both front and rear, standing well naturally and over plenty of ground. Exceptional profile action carriage and true on the down and back. BOB, Group 1 and finally my choice for Best in Show.

2. Officer's Eeri Catch The Wind. 4 yr old bitch with pleasing neck, deep brisket, nice spring of rib, arch over the loin and tail of correct set. Feminine headpiece of good proportions, correct rose-shaped ears and scissor bite but eyes did not please. She stands nice and straight in front and has lovely rear angulation. Moving pretty well all through but totally outshone by winner.
