#### FOOTBALL PITCHES - HANWORTH SIDE OF A316

You will remember that Power League have gained planning permission for pitches on the grass on the far side of the A316. They also wanted to be able to supply alcohol from 11am until 10.30pm Monday to Friday, from 11am until 8pm on Saturdays and from 12pm until 9.30pm on Sundays. The licensing meeting was held on Tuesday 17th February and we are delighted to report that we have achieved considerably reduced licensing hours of only from 6pm to 10.30 Monday to Friday. 6pm until 8pm only on Saturday, and 6pm until 9.30pm on Sundays and alcohol can only be consumed **inside** the building.

#### OUR ROADS

We continue to press for our Estate to become a 20mph Area ("Area" means no lumps/bumps just signage). As residents, for our mutual benefit and safety, let us all drive at this speed now, we don't have to wait for some signs to make this official. We are also pressing Hounslow Council for the following to increase safety on our Estate:

- A "smiley" flashing speed reduction sign on the sharp bend in Castle Way
- A lorry ban (except for deliveries) in Castle and Sunbury Way to make the lorries use Felthambrook Way instead
- Restricted parking outside the petrol station in Snakey Lane
- A "no right turn" from the roundabout under the A316 into the Mosque for safety reasons.

#### DOG FOULING

We have a number of dogs on the Estate and other dogs are walked through our roads. Most people are considerate but there have been issues over the last year with fouling of the pavements and grass verges.
