We complained to London Borough of Hounslow about the geographical error in their advertising and a Hanworth Councillor was asked to look into this. Needless to say its still "Sunbury." We have also asked a councillor to review the planning permission in relation to the planting of trees along the boundary to the A316 as this was to help shield homes in Sunbury and Castle Way from noise and light pollution.

### No Cold Calling Zone

Please remember that we live in a "no cold calling zone". This means that tradesmen cannot knock on your door uninvited and tout for business. If someone does come to your property, take their business card and give it to someone on the committee so that we can report this to Hounslow Trading Standards. Tell the tradesman that they are "in the zone" and close the door.

We have some roundels made especially for us that we will be distributing to members after renewal reminding tradesmen of the zone and again this should help to deter unsolicited doorstep visits.

### **Traffic / Pedestrian News**

Hounslow Council have gone ahead with making all residential estates 20 miles an hour areas. The 20 miles an hour applies to **ALL OF US**, our visitors, and everyone else using our roads and is for our mutual benefit and safety.

There are still vehicles coming into Raleigh Way from Snakey Lane up the no entry section. There is nothing further we can do as a residents association and we would urge you to stand your ground if you meet another car and have them reverse.

- There is now a lorry ban (except for deliveries) in Castle and Sunbury Way and this is to ensure transient HGVs use Felthambrook Way instead
- We have double yellow lines outside the petrol station in Snakey Lane to stop lorries parking in the road causing congestion and difficulty when exiting Raleigh Way (but they still do)
- We are still campaigning for a "no right turn" from the roundabout under the A316 into the Mosque for safety reasons.
- We are pressing LBH to review the parking on Sunbury Way and help residents by allowing them to park with 2 wheels on the pavement
- We are still working on zebra or controlled pedestrian crossings on the slip-roads of the A316 and Sunbury Way to help us cross to use the bus routes but the attitude of TfL, who are responsible for these roads is, that until someone dies we stand little chance. Please be careful so that is not you or your child who has to be the victim.
- A H25 bus stop heading towards Hanworth at the end of Sunbury Way is planned sometime this year. We are
  concerned that LBH and TfL are intending to site this almost opposite the existing stop ignoring our concerns
  regarding congestion and safety and will go ahead with this as the cheap option when insetting the bus stop into
  the grass area near to the roundabout would be by far the more sensible decision.

### Vermin

Another warm Winter has done nothing to reduce the local fox and rat population. Please do your best to help keep numbers down by not putting food out for the birds where vermin can get to it easily and keeping your food waste container secure

### **TERA Summer Social**

We are hoping to have a social at some point during the warmer months. We have yet to finalise plans and the venue and will advertise the date etc nearer the time.

### **Gardens Trees & Verges**

The daffodils planted last autumn have given us a cheerful reminder of Spring, and we hope to add more this year to fill in any gaps and add more blooms. An extra "Spring" competition will take place this year for the best displays, as so many gardens are at their best in this season. Judging will take place over the Easter weekend, so keep the bulbs, spring bedding and blossom looking good. The usual summer competition will take place too, details and dates to be announced later.

Some of our grass verges continue to show signs of misuse. Please don't park on the grass verges or let your visitors do so unless it is a real emergency. If you are having works done to your home and the verge becomes damaged then please see it as your responsibility to put this right. It is unfair for you/your visitors to trash the verge and then the rest of us have to look at the mess. LBH wont be doing anything about it so it is up to us to keep our Estate looking good.
