Neighbourhood Watch

There have been some incidents of cars being 'unlawfully entered' recently. Please be aware and make sure your car is properly locked. Consider keeping your car key/fob in a metal box, as this might stop the thieves from accessing the code from a modern key fob. There have also been some opportunistic house break-ins. Thankfully no one was hurt, although quite understandably a great deal of shock and anger was felt. Also, be aware of leaving garage doors open whilst 'popping round to the back garden' as several properties on the Estate have had items stolen from the garage during a brief window of opportunity!! Finally, please ensure that all ground floor windows are securely closed at night and when you leave your home, particularly in the Summer

Traffic / Pedestrian News
