PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

Entries to be received at the Community Centre, Sexton Street

Friday 12th September 7:30pm—9:30pm

Saturday 13th September 8:00am—9:30am

(Entry desk will close promptly at 9:30am)

All staging must be completed by 9:45am

Judging is between 10am and 12 noon (during which the marquees and hall will be closed to the public)

Show opens at 1pm

Prizes and Awards at 4pm followed by the Auction of donated Products and Crafts

Refreshments served from 1pm in the marquee

RULES

1. In all classes, entries will be accepted between 7:30pm and 9:30pm on Friday 12th September and on Saturday 13th September between 8am and 9:30am at the Community Centre, Sexton Street, Tintwistle SK13 1JY. (Please note that the entry desk will close **PROMPTLY** at 9:30am).
2. TAGA is not liable for any loss of and/or damage to exhibits whether in competitive or non competitive displays and other property of exhibitors from any cause.
3. Staging **MUST** be completed by 9:45am on the day of the Show.
4. Judging will commence at 10am.
5. Entry fees—all classes 50p per entry. Children free for all classes. Entry in the Show implies acceptance of the rules.
6. Entry forms must be handed to the Show Secretary no later than 9:30am on Saturday 13th September. Exhibitors must pay their entry fees with their entry forms.
7. Varieties must be named in all flower, fruit and vegetable classes.
8. Judging to be in accordance with RHS, NDS, NCS, NVS rules where appropriate.
9. Trophies are the property of TAGA and must be returned by 30th August the following year.
10. All entries must be grown in the exhibitor's own garden or allotment and must have been grown on by the exhibitor for at least 3 months. This does not apply to the Children's, Handicrafts and Cookery sections.
11. All exhibits must be prepared and cleaned thoroughly before being staged. No preparation or cleaning in the Hall or Marquee area. There will be a designated area.
12. Exhibitors may stage any number of exhibits in any class for which they qualify except in categories which state a specific number of exhibits for that class.
13. Two or more persons may not compete separately in the same class with produce from the same allotment or garden. If they wish to share the credit and prizes then the exhibit must be entered under joint names.
14. We have limited space for staging and you must not move any other exhibits to create space for yours. Stewards will give advice and make any appropriate adjustments.
15. Exhibits must not be removed before the close of the Show. Judges' decisions in all cases are final. Objections other than on merit may be lodged with the Committee on payment of a £1 deposit, to be forfeited if not upheld. Awards may be withheld at the Judges' discretion.
16. Failure to comply with instructions in the brochure means disqualification.
17. In the event of a tie where awards are made for most number of first prizes, if necessary seconds and thirds will count.
18. Prize money will be awarded as indicated for each category and can be collected between 5 and 6pm on the day of the Show and afterwards by contacting the Show Treasurer.
