Dear all.

Thank you for your participation in another week of organizing and resistance. We continue to mourn the unceasing carnage and bloodshed in Gaza. The immense psychological toll of living through constant displacement and military attacks is expressed by Maram Humaid, Al Jazeera English's digital correspondent in Gaza: "The Earth is shrinking under our feet. We're being punished, squeezed into a tiny bottleneck, bombarded and torn apart... I feel like a spinning top, my concentration shattered by the looming tragedy of another evacuation, no matter how hard I try to resist the thought." In Lebanon on Friday, an Israeli strike killed at least eight people, including a child.

In heartening news, the BDS movement has secured a major victory in pushing French multinational AXA to sell its investments in all major Israeli banks. This is a significant win for the BDS movement, and proof of the efficacy of its methods. Leading up to the DNC, the Uncommitted movement led a national "Not Another Bomb" call to action, which saw protests and rallies nationally and around the globe, calling for democratic nominee Kamala Harris to commit to a permanent ceasefire. Unfortunately the DNC lost a huge opportunity to engage the Uncommitted when it refused the request for a Palestinian American to speak to the convention. For coverage of the myriad protests, first ever panel on Palestinian rights, and other Palestine-related action inside and outside the DNC, check out Democracy Now!'s reporting.

This week offers more opportunities for action, education, and community building, including a talk on the 2024 election at the Fletcher Free Library in Burlington and a celebration of Palestinian culture and heritage at Antioch University in Keene. In this long and often painful struggle, we recognize the importance of community and relationship building, and the value each of us as unique individuals bring to our collective movement.
