Hello all,

This week, Amnesty International released a report titled "You Feel Like You Are Subhuman: Israel's Genocide Against Palestinians in Gaza," a detailed account of the Israeli state's genocidal rhetoric and action from October 7th, 2023 to the present. Amnesty International Secretary General Agnes Callamard calls on governments around the world to do everything they can to stop the transfer of weapons to Israel and hold those who are accountable for these ongoing atrocities to justice.

Amnesty joins a number of national and international groups who have declared Israel's actions genocidal, including the Center for Constitutional Rights in the U.S, UN special rapporteur Francesca Albanese, and the International Criminal Court. The U.S and Israeli government continue to refute these charges.

Meanwhile, Israel continues its assault on Gaza, including the killing of 20 Palestinians in an air strike in Khan Younis on Wednesday, as well as raiding the city of Nablus in the West Bank, arresting 28 and forcing several families out of their homes. Despite an ostensible ceasefire, Lebanon has reported that Israel has breached the ceasefire more than 60 times, through airstrikes and gunfire.

Our sustained engagement in this fight remains invaluable. These coming weeks provide local opportunities for protest, skill-building, education, collective grieving, and movement building.
