Hello all,

We wish you warmth and light from your community in these days of darkness.

As the genocide in Gaza becomes ever more horrific, media attention has swiveled to other matters. In mainstream news, there are daily updates on the investigation into the assassination of a health insurance company executive, but there are few stories about the people being killed every day by US policy as usual, including via US weapons in Palestine or by the denial of insurance coverage, housing, and other human rights here in the US. Outside of the spotlight, however, there is increasing awareness of this hypocrisy, thanks in part to the organizing of JVP and other groups.

Since the ousting of the al-Assad regime in Syria earlier this month, the Israeli military has bombed many areas in Syria intensely and seized a demilitarized zone in the Golan Heights (see map and article from NYT <u>here</u>). This offensive makes clear the expansionism that defines Israeli policy and the reluctance of the US to condemn it.

Israel has closed its embassy in Ireland after Ireland's leaders condemned the genocide in the occupied Palestinian territories. In the US, Palestinians are suing the federal government for violating the Leahy Law by continuing aid to Israeli military units despite obvious human rights violations.

Our upcoming plans include a chapter-wide Zoom meeting to regroup and reconnect as we continue this struggle. Please be in touch with comments, questions, or to connect with a local crew.
