- Matt McConnell has already been in contact with Water Service following reports of a dangerously corroded drain cover on the lane down to the play-park. This was addressed immediately by the Water Service and a new cover is now in place
- We also discussed the need to possibly register as a charity. Neil volunteered to look into this, Neil also agreed to setting up a web page for the group that we could use for getting information out to the local community about what is happening or in the pipeline.
- Matt had agreed to contact Transport NI about the speed calming measures and the flooding at the corner opposite the Bar.
- Michael agreed to contact the PSNI about any assistance with the speed calming measures and also about starting up a neighbourhood watch programme in the area.
- John had agreed to chat with Mr Knight (teacher from the local primary school) about the possibility of extending the local greenway and getting him to address to group at some point in the future as the extension of the Greenway is a project he is working on.
- Possibility of street furniture was also discussed in-keeping with village mill/ tower heritage.
