**Matt & Mick** have been chasing up the councillors regarding work that still requires doing in the village. Matt has also attended an interagency meeting via zoom to raise some of these issues. It's frustratingly slow progress but Alan Lewis replied to Matt to let him know the village will be getting the gutters cleaned out in October. Mick has requested again that the road sweeper visit the village before this happens as has Matt. We will keep trying.

Hopefully over the next month a questionnaire will be rolled out across the village to see where the main areas of concern are in respect of all the residents.
