The State Approving Agency (SAA) has completed its review of the submitted application packet for approval to offer Prep Courses for certification under Chapter 36, Title 38, U.S. Code, Sec. 3315.

The SAA has determined the school's qualifications are satisfactory and the following preparatory courses meet the legal intent of Public Law 116-154, 38 USC § 3315b. The approval is granted effective May 1, 2025 under the legal authority of 38 USC §3315b.

- Prep courses are offered through the Lean Alaska MS TEAMS platform.
- Prep courses are approved for reimbursement of cost only.
- There is no monetary cap for the courses; costs are charged to the VA student's educational entitlement.
- For educational assistance to be payable for a license or certification, the exam must already be approved under Code of Federal Regulation 21.4268(b).
- Beneficiaries may repeat the course as many times they deem necessary.

This approval will remain in effect, both in content and policy, as certified by the school. Any changes to policies or programs must be submitted to the SAA as a modification for review and re-approval within 30 days of the change.

Statement of verification

- The educational institution does not utilize advertising, sales, or enrollment practices that are erroneous, deceptive, or misleading practices either by actual statement, omission, or



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intimation;

- The educational institution maintains a written record of the previous education and training of the eligible person or veteran that indicates appropriate credit has been given by the academic institution for prior education and training, with the training period shortened proportionately;
- A copy of the course outline, schedule of tuition, fees, and other charges, regulations pertaining to absences, grading policy, and rules of operation and conduct will be furnished the veteran or eligible person upon enrollment;
- Upon completion of training, the veteran or eligible person is given a certificate by the school indicating the approved course and indicating that training was satisfactorily completed;
- Adequate records as prescribed by the SAA are kept showing attendance and progress or grades, and satisfactory standards relating to attendance, progress, and conduct are enforced and;
- The school maintains a policy for the pro rata refund of the unused portion of tuition, fees, and charges if the veteran or eligible person fails to enter the course or withdraws or is discontinued from it before completion.

Conditions of approval:

Approval is granted under the responsibilities delegated to the SAA under Title 38, Chapter 36, U.S.C. Sections 3671(a) and 3672(a).

The institution must notify the SAA within 30 days of the receipt of any punitive action taken by a State or any other federal department or agency that violates the standards as defined by VA.

This approval is subject to acceptance by the Department of Veterans Affairs Regional Office.

Failure to submit timely notifications and deviation from information in the application packet, which served as the basis for granting this approval, may result in adverse administrative sanctions.

The United States Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) administers education benefits. This approval does not guarantee payment. DVA may not release education payments for programs determined to not meet Title 38 requirements.

Under 38 CFR § 21.4258, a copy of this approval notice, any attachments, amendments, catalog, and student handbook (if applicable) have been submitted to the Muskogee VA Regional Office.
