



*Mzia Zhvania*, PhD and ScD, is a Professor of Neuroanatomy at Ilia State University and Head of Laboratory of Brain Ultrastructure and Nanoarchitecture at I. Beritashvili Center of Experimental Biomedicine. Mzia Zhvania graduated Tbilisi State University and continued her studies as aspirant (PhD student) at Institute of Brain, USSR Medical Academy of Science (Moscow). She obtained her first scientific degree in “Cytology” and second degree – in “Cell Biology”. Mzia Zhvania had trainings or performed research in several foreign scientific organizations, including University of Prague, Kuopio University, Iowa State University, Institute of Brain Bulgarian Academy of Science and others.

Mzia Zhvania’s area of interests are structural/ultrastructural aspects of brain neuropathologies, and cellular and molecular mechanisms of cell secretion.

Mzia Zhvania is a recipient of several research grants and awards. She is a member of several international scientific organizations, including IBRO, FENS, Georgian Neuroscience Association (Board member), SfN and Sigma Xi (The Scientific Research Honor Society).
