









# Task breakdown of Chinese calligraphy

Steps		Key points
1	The right way of holding the brush	
2	Open your palm naturally like this picture 	Use your writing hand. If it is your left hand, you go mirror side with thumb up.
3	Curl your little finger and ring finger 	Try to keep your palm flat.
4	Place your brush between your middle finger and ring finger 	Use four fingers to hold the brush.

5	<p>Your thumb place between your index finger and middle finger, thumb goes upwards better.</p> 	<p>Use five fingers to hold your brush.</p>
6 Horizontal line writing methods		
7	<p>1. to start the brush—slightly turn left as directed in this picture, then slightly going down and hold the point to make the start of the line a little bit bigger.</p> 	<p>This is the starting point writing.</p>
8	<p>2. Draw the line—use middle point of your brush to draw towards right side slowly.</p> 	<p>Drawing the middle parts of this line.</p>
9	<p>3. Finishing the line—your brush slightly goes up, folds back in 45 degrees' angle, hold the point, finally gently comes back to the</p> 	<p>This is the finishing point.</p>

	line and lift you brush at the same time.	
		
10	Repeat above steps three times to write a character three in your handout paper.
