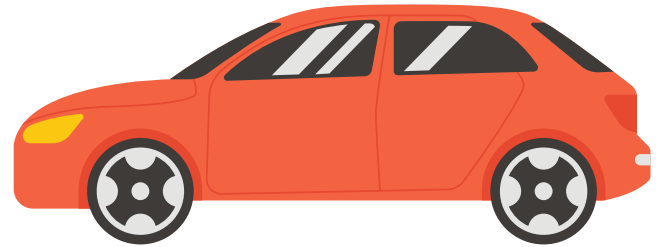


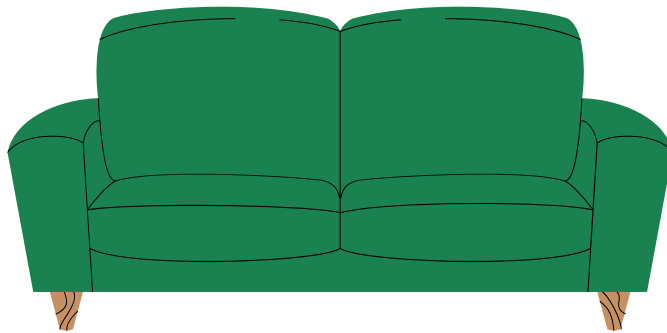

Mandatory Bills: Bills they have to pay before their due dates.

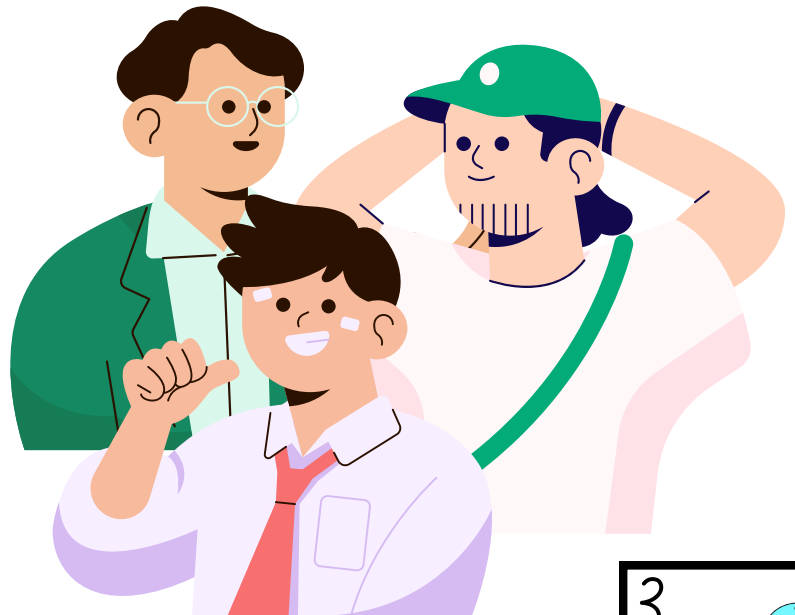
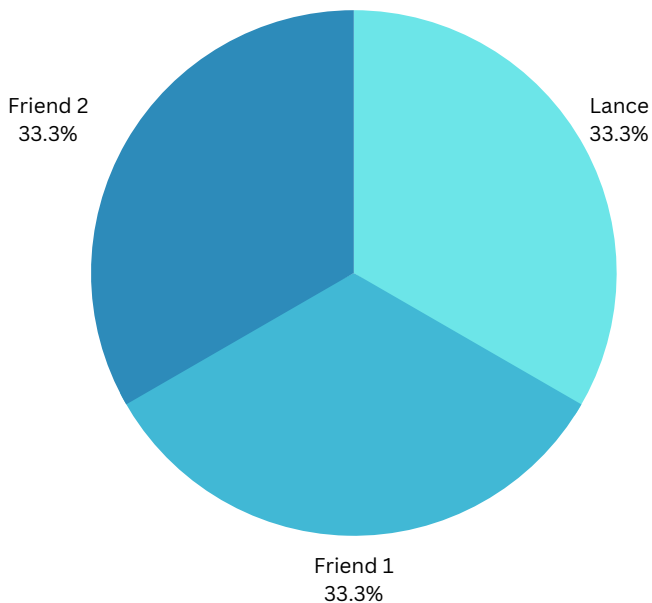
Optional Bills: Bills they can opt out of any time to save on monthly bills.

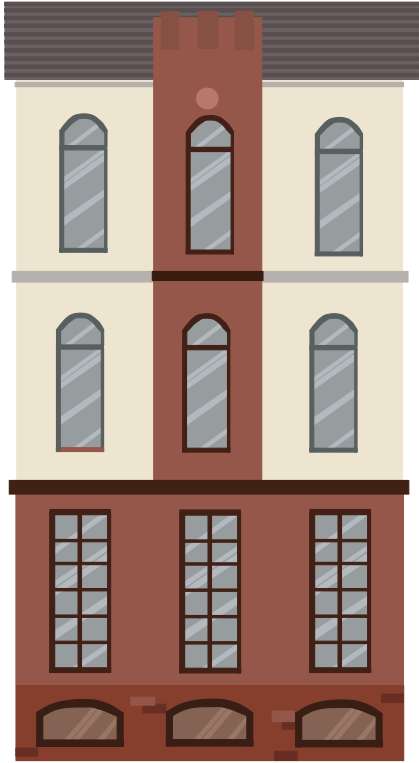
Lance wants to budget 33% of his monthly budget on rent. How much is he budgeting?
