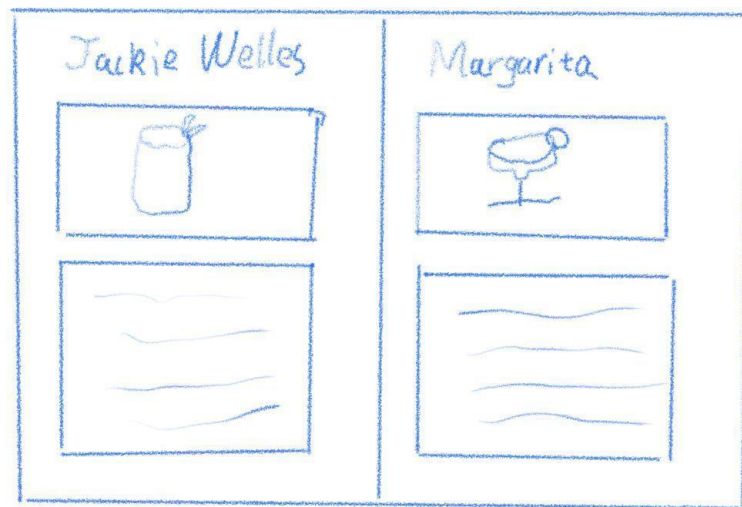


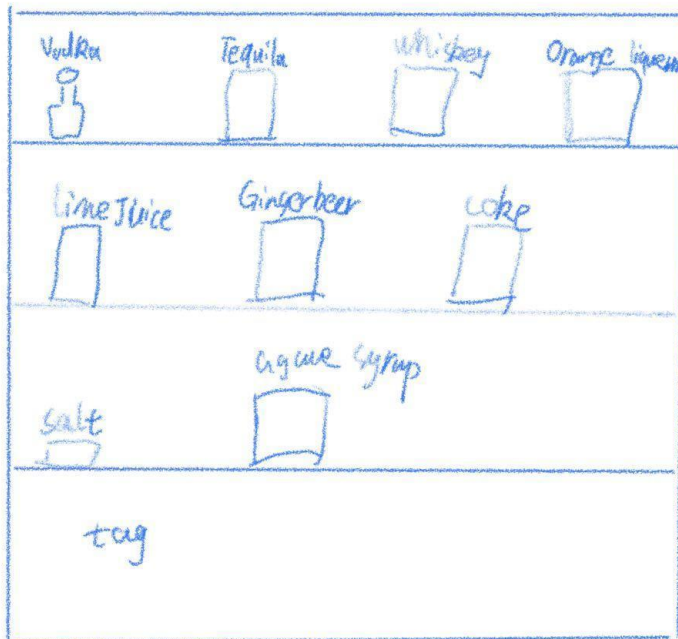
# Level Design

## Level 2: Living Room

The detective came to the living room. He looked around and tried to open the door of the second bedroom on the first floor, but found that it could not be opened, and the stair door leading to the second floor was also closed. The detective's sixth sense told him that he could find it in the room. Lots of clues. The scene in the living room is as warm as I remembered, but because no one lives there all the year round, it is covered with dust. To the right of the door is the bar and kitchen. The wine on the wine cabinet has not been touched yet. Maybe the wine inside is not drinkable. ( The detective's sixth sense "highlights the books and wine cabinets on the bar when approaching the bar", related associations: I used to mix drinks with my wife in the kitchen). The detective comes to the bar, interacts with the wine list, and opens the wine list. There are three wines in the wine list, namely "Jackie Welles", "David Martinez", and "Margarita".



In the wine list, Margarita's practice says that the salt represents the tears of the lover, and it is marked as the wife's favorite wine, but there is a tag on the page that reads "I don't like the tears of the lover", and the wine list is closed. (Three clues are obtained: "Jackie Welles", "David Martinez", and "Margarita"), the detective walks to the wine cabinet, interacts with the wine cabinet, enters the bartending mini-game, there is wine on the wine cabinet, and a note It says when you forget how to mix a drink, remember to check the recipe



After calling out Margarita, you will get the key clue "Margarita" (1).

The detective continued to search for clues in the living room. When he walked to the TV cabinet, the detective's sixth sense would highlight the movie "Murder on the Orient Express" on the TV cabinet. Interacting with the film, the detective would say to himself "I remember buying this film 16 years ago, when we used to watch movies together on the couch". Get the key clue "Murder on the Orient Express" (2).

The detective continues to search for clues in the living room, there is a broken violin in the room, the detective's sixth sense will highlight the violin, interact with the violin, the detective will say to himself "violin, I like to listen to her play while drinking, But why does the string break?". Get the key clue "Violin with Broken Strings". (3)

The detective continues to search for clues in the living room. When walking past the record player, the detective's sixth sense will highlight the record player, interact with the record player, and the detective will say to himself "emmmm, old song from 16 years ago, it still sounds good ". Get the key clue "The Record". (4)

The detective continues to search for clues in the living room. The safe is next to the bookshelf. The detective's sixth sense will highlight the safe. Click on the words on the safe. The first line is blank and the second line is LOCK. The detective said to himself, what is the code? Maybe there will be clues on the shelf. "Then the bookshelves will be highlighted, interactive bookshelves, and the detective will say to himself, 'These books, look like they are trying to convey a message'. A book is called Sherlock Foxmes, and there is a hollow space inside the book that looks like it can be placed. A ring (same as The Shawshank Redemption). By solving the puzzle, it is found that the password is SHER, which is the name of the book SHERLOCK. Open the safe to see an open ring box, and get the key clue "Open Ring Box".

The memory hall is highlighted and a prompt is issued. The player needs to put five clues in the empty space in the memory hall. After the key clues are collected, the

player enters the memory. Once, he and his wife were very beautiful. Watch movies together on the sofa, play music and tell detective stories during naps. At the end of the memory, the second bedroom door on the first floor is still closed, the stairs on the second floor can be interacted and highlighted, and the player can enter the master bedroom on the second floor.

#### Level4: Study Room

The detective gets the key to the study room from the master bedroom, returns to the first floor, and enters the study.

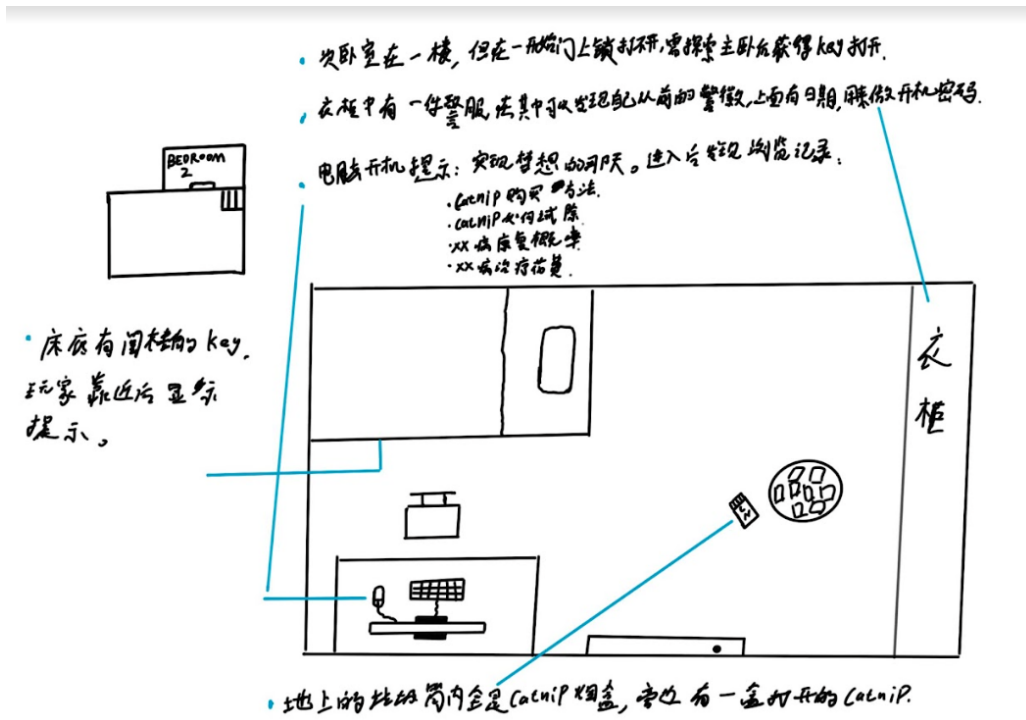
There was a trash can on the floor of the study, filled with catnip cigarette boxes, and an unfinished box of catnip scattered on the floor next to it. The detective walked over to check, very puzzled muttering to himself: "Why is there catnip here, when I lived here, I obviously did not have ..., forget it, it just so happens that the cigarettes I brought also smoked out, take this pack with you." Get the prop, catnip.

The detective then saw his computer, opened it and found that he needed a password, and the password prompt was: the day he realized his dream. The detective said to himself, "Damn, how come I can't even remember my password, time to look elsewhere for clues." Then looking through the bookcase, on the bookcase found his badge when he was a detective, with the time he became a police officer: 2010.10.1 The detective then said to himself, "Becoming a police officer has always been my dream as a child."

The computer password is 2010101, after entering the correct password, the detective can open the computer. The browsing record of the computer shows in order:  
2012.4.23 XX disease treatment expenses  
2012.4.24 Chance of recovery from XX disease  
2012.5.15 Antidepressants  
2012.5.20 How to quit Catnip  
2012.6.2 Catnip purchase channels

After reading all the browsing records, the detective fell into deep thought: "Impossible, this is absolutely not true, I should not have been addicted to drugs at that time, all my efforts are to cure my wife is right, how can I be on drugs!"

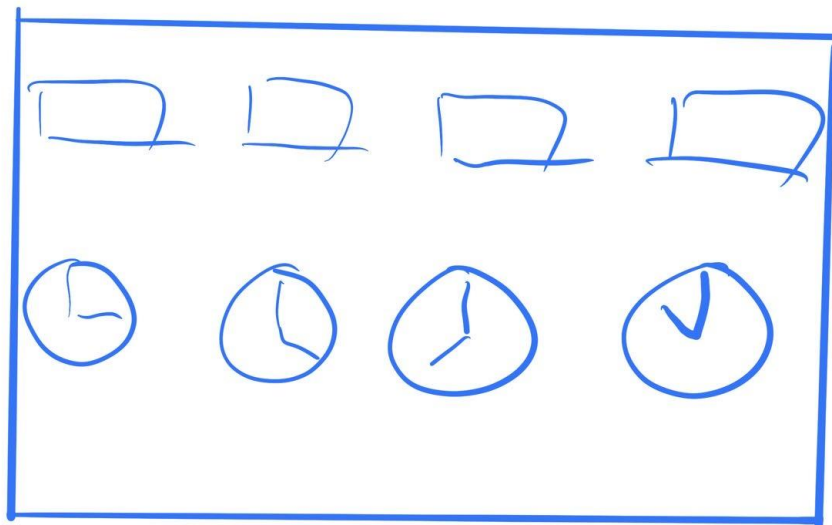
At that moment there was a crisp sound from the bed behind him, as if something had fallen to the floor. The detective found the key to the attic by the bed. "This should be the key to the attic, I'm going up there to find out what's going on, the whole thing is really bizarre, damn it!"



Level 5: Attic

The detective went up to the attic, which was very small, with only a desk, a whiteboard, and a small safe. There is a small box on the table, which is the detective's favorite game. There are different boards. The detective needs to buckle down the 16 cards, face up, and shuffle the order. Only two cards can be turned over at a time. Turn over and remember the order of the small animals on the board, and eliminate them two by two. After the player has eliminated all the cards, a string of words "Time is the way to find the truth" is on the board. (Get the clue: the text behind the board) The detective saw a series of watches on the table, which recorded the time of 4 different Zootopia, the detective put the watch into the backpack, the watch into the backpack and the memory hall (obtained the clue: Zootopia's time) time). The detective would say to himself "I wonder if it's been too long, these watches are gone". The four times represent the password (xxxx) of the safe from left to right. Open the safe by collecting the code and get the key to the roof. When I came to the whiteboard again, the writing on the whiteboard had gradually become invisible over time, but there was still some information on the yellowed paper. The information was about a murder chase ten years ago. The detective arranged and connected the paper on the whiteboard. Sequence, recalled that because of his unknown mistakes (sudden withdrawal reaction, suggesting that he had been taking drugs ten years ago), his partner, Officer Nunu, died in the line of duty, and he also faced a period of suspension and investigation, which made him There was no income for a period of time, which became the last straw that broke the camel's back. (Get the clue: The straw that broke the camel's back)

The memory hall highlights and prompts that players need to connect all clues, and then enter the memory after connecting the clues. After returning home, his seriously ill wife took the initiative to come to the attic and took him to the roof to watch the sunrise and sunset. Suddenly the roof seemed to be The wife's voice came, calling the detective to go up. The ladder to the top of the building is highlighted, and the detective can go to the top floor. The detective had a withdrawal reaction again before walking to the ladder, but he heard the repeated calls of his wife, so he quickly injected himself with a shot, the screen appeared blurred special effects (lasting 5s), and then the detective went upstairs and entered the top floor.
