(COVID-19) Update 17/03/2020



Coronavirus has now been declared a public health emergency of international concern and has spread to numerous countries around the World.

As a childcare company, with a presence in Primary School we at UPS are regularly speaking to health professionals to put together procedures in place to best help us manage the COVID-19 outbreak.

The risk to children in our care is being minimised by following strict Government guidance, we ask families not to attend our clubs until they have completed a 14-day period at home if travelled abroad to effected areas or have shown any symptoms.

At **UPS** we routinely practice high standards of infection control. We are committed to reducing the risk by ensuring effective hygiene practices are in place for both children and staff and we encourage full participation in these practices;

- Wash hands frequently with soap, especially before eating or handling food, after toilet visits, or when hands are contaminated by respiratory secretions after coughing or sneezing.
- Cover their mouth and nose with a tissue when sneezing or coughing, and to discard the tissue immediately into a bin.
- · No sharing of food/ drinks with others.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces, toys and equipment regularly and when contaminated by nasal or oral secretions.
- Ensure supplies such as hand soap, tissues, and paper towels are available for children and staff's use.

As always, we remain vigilant in ensuring regular thorough cleaning is carried out and our housekeeping is effective. We continually monitor the health of children in our care and will react quickly in the event of any rise in temperature or changes in behaviour.
