Please make sure your child brings a water bottle to school every day. Encourage them to drink water regularly to stay hydrated, especially during physical activities.

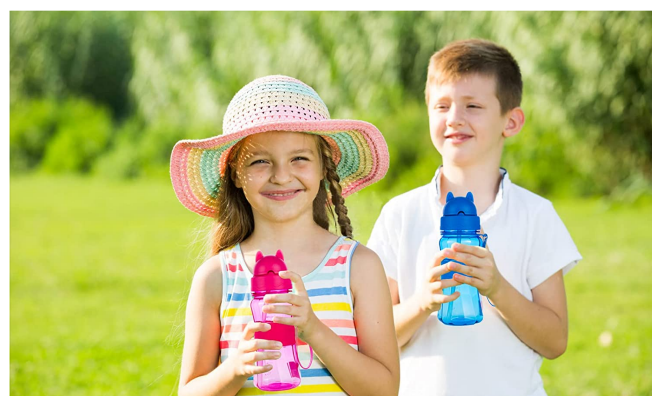
Sun Cream:
