The number of animals entered and the number of pens required must be advised on your entry form – pens are for animals only.

ENTRY FEE: £10 per class plus £5 per pen

TRAVEL MONEY: Paid to any exhibitor bringing 3 or more animals (excluding calves). Graduated payment dependent on distance to show “ as the crow flies”, *£10 for upto 10 miles, £15 for upto 15 miles, £20 for upto 20 miles, £25 for upto 25 miles, £30 for 25 miles plus.*

PRIZE MONEY: For all classes 1st£20.00 2nd£15.00 3rd£10.00

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please report to Bio Security Officer before unloading lorry to ensure adherence to the current DEFRA Regulations. All cattle entered must produce TB clearance certificates if applicable.

Cattle must have a valid PASSPORT and MOVEMENT CERTIFICATE on the day. No lorries to be unloaded until advised. Please make sure all wheel arches on all vehicles are disinfected before arrival on the showground.

Please use special Livestock entrance on the day.

All animals must be HALTER TRAINED AND LED . All exhibitors must comply with MOVEMENT DOCUMENTATION to the satisfaction of Surrey Trading Standards.

All exhibitors must fill in ENTRY FORMS before the Show.
All Cattle are to be on showground by 9.00am, with judging commencing at 9.30 am on both days.

JUDGES FOR BOTH DAYS TO BE ADVISED

All cattle should remain until after the Grand Parade in the Main Ring on both days.

Admission is at the discretion of the Chertsey Agricultural Association.
