



# 5th Halloween ART ALONG THE SIDEWALK CONTEST

Help turn Walkkill into the **HAUNTED HAMLET** for Halloween.  
Open to any age. Now until September 20, 2024

**What is Art Along the Sidewalk?** Lawn signs are painted or decorated with a spooky, Halloween theme. The artwork is judged and then displayed along roads and sidewalks to help decorate the hamlet for Halloween!

**Prizes:** A **\$25 Amazon Gift Card** for **1<sup>st</sup> place elementary grade student**; **1<sup>st</sup> place upper grade student**; and **1<sup>st</sup> place adult**. There will also be runner-up prizes for students.

We are asking for a **\$5 entry fee** for your commitment to complete a spooky, fun, Halloween picture. You will be provided a blank, corrugated plastic 18"x24" lawn sign as your canvas. The long side of the canvas is the horizontal side; the short side of the canvas is the vertical side. Please seal your own work. Acrylic paint that is sealed with Modge Podge works best. On the back of the artwork, write in bold 2-inch (minimum) letters: "Art Along the Sidewalk" and "By Vision of Walkkill", along with the child's first name, initial of last name and grade. Adults-write your first name, initial of last name and "Adult".

**To Enter:** You can pick up a blank sign and register on:

- August 6, 5 – 9 pm at the Vision of Walkkill table at National Night Out at Garrison Park
- August 7 to September 16 at Walkkill Public Library & Shawangunk Town Clerk's Office during their regular business hours
- You will need to provide your \$5 entry fee when you pick up your blank sign

**To Drop Off Finished Artwork:**

- Shawangunk Town Clerk's Office by Friday Sept. 20, 4 pm
- Walkkill Public Library Sept. 18 - Sept. 20, 5 pm
- Vision of Walkkill table on Library Lawn Friday Sept. 20, 5 – 7 pm

**Judging:** Sept. 21, 10 am - 2:30 pm at Weekend of Walkkill on the library lawn

Artwork will be placed on roads and streets in the hamlet by Sept. 29 and will be collected by VOW after Halloween. Artists will be notified to pick up their artwork at the Shawangunk Town Hall, sometime in early November.
