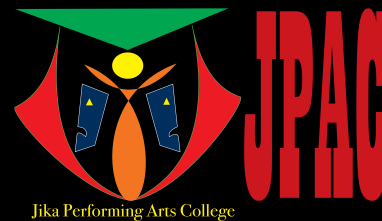

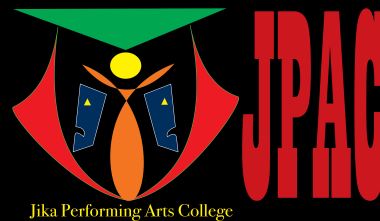

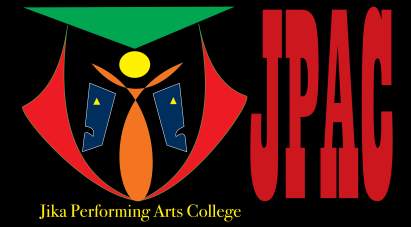


OBJECTIVES

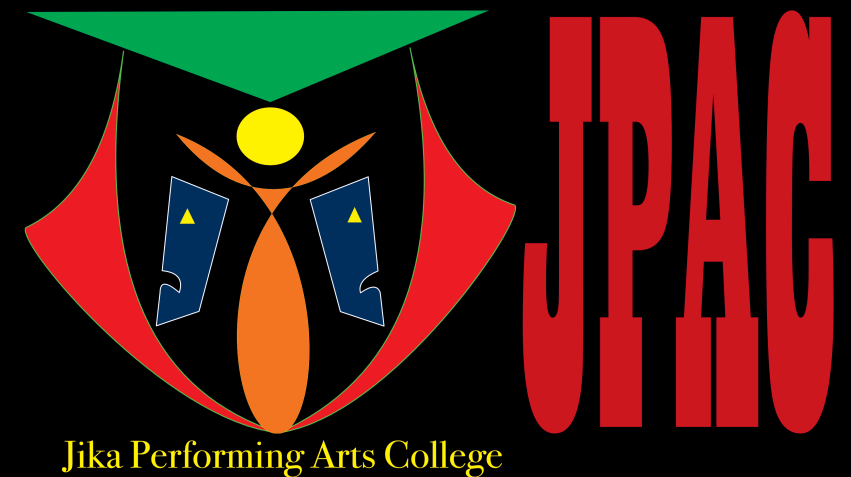
