ROUTE, DISTANCES & TIMES

- 1** Faizan-e-Madina Masjid & Islamic Centre to Lincoln Cathedral
1.6 miles 35–40 min
- 2** Lincoln Cathedral to Jews' Court
0.2 mile 4–5 min
- 3** Jews' Court to Friends Meeting House (Lincoln Quaker Meeting)
0.3 mile 5–7 min
- 4** Friends Meeting House (Lincoln Quaker Meeting) to St Hugh's Catholic Church
0.4 mile 6–8 min
- 5** St Hugh's Catholic Church to The Salvation Army
0.5 mile 8–10 min
- 6** The Salvation Army to Lincoln Unitarian Chapel
0.2 mile 3–4 min
- 7** Lincoln Unitarian Chapel to TCfR Interfaith Centre at Central Methodist Church
0.3 mile 5–6 min

TOTAL DISTANCE
About 3.7 – 3.8 miles

TOTAL WALKING TIME
About 75 – 90 minutes
(excluding stops and reflections)
